Baptism of the Lord

The Baptism of the Christ is the feast day commemorating the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by John the Baptist. Originally the baptism of Christ was celebrated on Epiphany, which commemorates the coming of the Magi, the baptism of Christ, and the wedding at Cana. Over time in the West, however, the celebration of the baptism of the Lord came to be commemorated as a distinct feast from Epiphany.

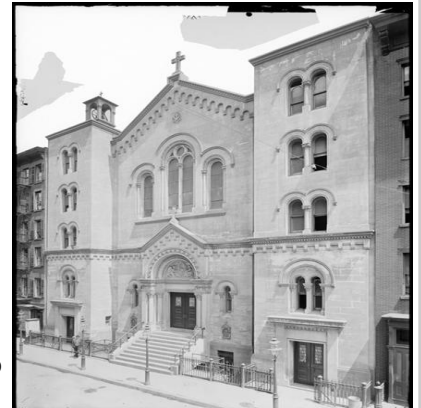
OPEN. You can come into the office with your list, mail it to us or, if your list is relatively short, call it in.

THE 2020 WEEKLY COLLECTION ENVELOPES are on the table on the left as you enter the church. If you are a regular envelope user, please look for the box with your name and number and take it home, the sooner the better. The longer they are left out on the table, the better the chances of people randomly taking envelopes out of the box for use here and there even though someone else's name is on the box – we have had that issue in the past and it is a situation that is easier to avoid than to straighten out after it happens. For anyone wanting to use the envelope system for the first time, please come into the office and a box will be assigned to you.

EARLY NOTICE REGARDING OUR ANNUAL SAINT ANTHONY OF PADUA NOVENA: Our novena in honor of St. Anthony of Padua is scheduled to begin on March 17, 2020 which is St. Patrick's Day. The novena will be celebrated on 13 consecutive Tuesdays ending on Tuesday, June 9, 2020. All Tuesday Masses will be at 12:10PM. St. Anthony's feast day is June 13th which happens to fall on a Saturday this year, so we are assured of Mass being celebrated on his feast day. Our Saturday Masses are at 5:30PM. Of course, the Tuesday novena schedule is contingent upon availability of our clergy; any changes or updates will be published in future Bulletins. Let us not forget just two days following St. Patrick's Day and the beginning of the St. Anthony novena is St. Joseph's Day, March 19th. People have a tendency to overlook St. Joseph's Day despite him being one of the most important figures in Jesus and Mary's lives.
