## Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the liturgy of the post-Vatican II Roman Rite, Ordinary Time is that part of the Christian liturgical year that lacks the distinctive characters of the Paschal Triduum, Eastertide, Lent, Christmastide, and Advent, and is divided into two periods: that between Christmas and Lent, and that between Eastertide and Advent.

In the usage of the Revised Common Lectionary, the term "Ordinary Time" applies only to the second of these two periods. The word "ordinary" as used here is not meant to suggest that this period is plain or unremarkable, but is instead related to the word "ordinal" and emphasizes that these weeks are counted, from the 1st week of Ordinary Time to the 34th week.

The vestments worn by the priest at Mass will be green symbolizing the public ministry of Jesus which is reflected in the readings during this period.
