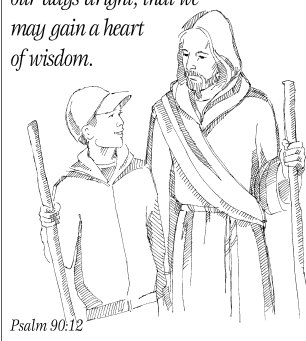

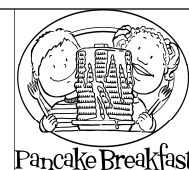

### Seniors on the Go

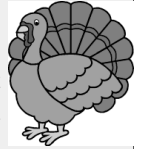

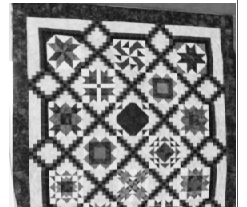
### Turkey Bingo is Friday Nov 6<sup>th</sup>.
