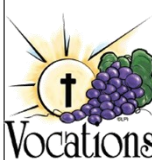


### Closer to the Eucharist through Prayer, Praise and Preparation.

**Office of Child and Youth Protection**

Parental Guidelines for Your Child's Cell Phone Use  
If you purchase a smartphone for your child, you are responsible both civilly and criminally for everything that your child does on that phone. Here are some actions you should consider:

- \* Contact the cell phone provider and block Internet access and calls from phone numbers that you have not approved. Many cell phone companies allow the parent to cap the number of texts a user can send or receive and the number of voice minutes that the cell phone can use.
- \* Designate certain times that the cell phone needs to be turned off—for instance during family meals, after 10pm and during school hours.
- \* Don't allow cell phones in your children's rooms at night to prevent them from texting or making calls after bedtime.
- \* Require parental permission to download each app by retaining the password required to install a new app on the device.
- \* Be vigilant—physically examine the phone regularly to make sure that it has not been modified. Check that the features you have disabled have not been re-enabled.
- \* If your child has a driver's license, insist that he or she never use the cell phone to call or text when driving.
