### Pilgrimage

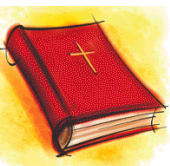

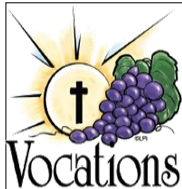
