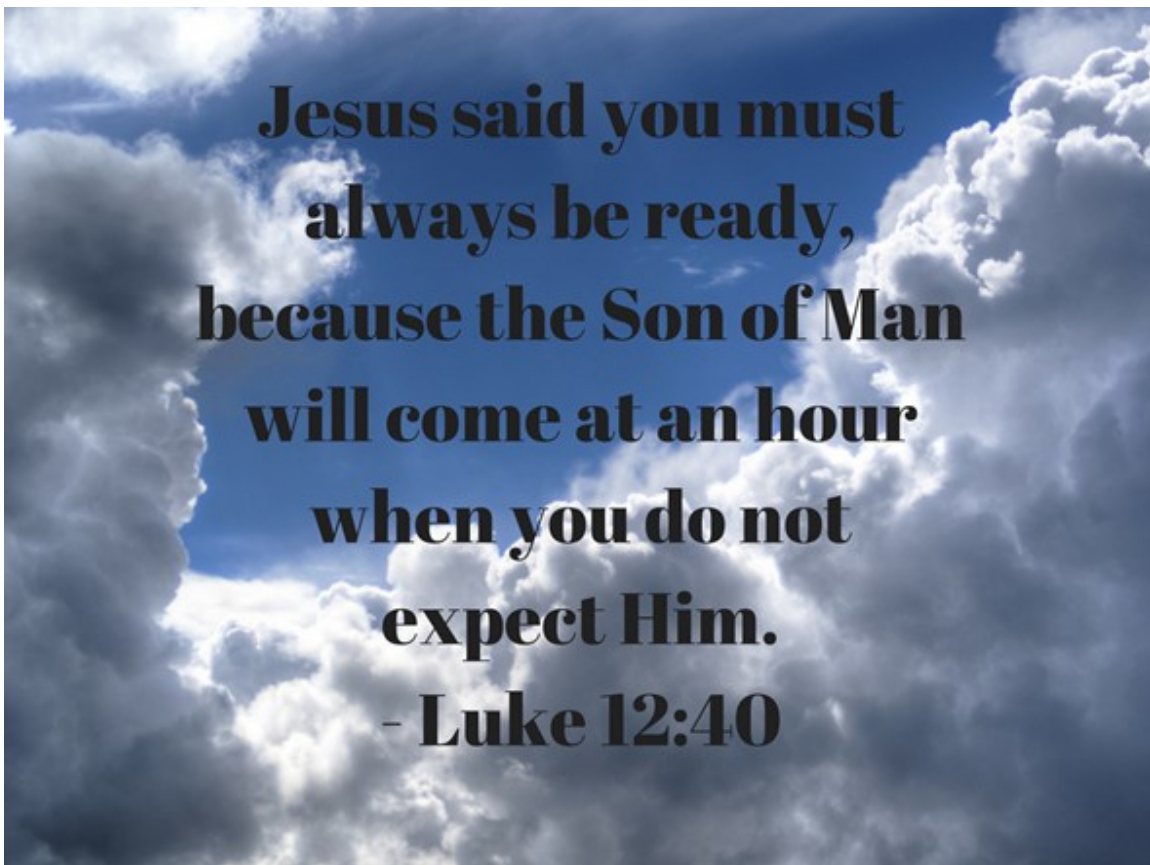

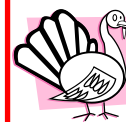

PrimeTime Mentoring

We will be continuing our PrimeTime Mentoring Program with Otis Orchards Elementary School Students. PrimeTime Mentoring is a rewarding, school-based program that requires only a 30-minute to one hour per week investment, in making a positive difference to an at-risk youth. PrimeTime mentors spend their time eating lunch while playing games, talking and doing activities one-on-one with a student. There will be a sign-up sheet in the foyer. We will be working with the School to expedite the match-up process so the mentoring can begin as soon as possible
