SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

The Commandment of Love.

The figure of the vine and the branches in John invites comparison with the Pauline doctrine of Christ the head of his body the Church. The Pauline idea however is far more developed; though John's Gospel was finished long after the Pauline epistles, John is faithful to the historical age in which the Gospel is set and therefore does not develop the figure beyond the application given it by Jesus. Love is the principle of the relation between the Father and the Son; the same love has brought the Church into being "remain in my love". The disciples must continue to keep themselves worthy of the protection of Christ's love. This is done by obedience to the will of Christ, again by following his example. "No one can have greater love", Christian love has as its model nothing less than the example of the Good Shepherd himself; in turn, the love of Christ gives the Christian the ability to live up to this ideal. "No longer do I call slaves", there was nothing degrading in been known as the slave of God or a good master; Jesus uses the term slave (doulos) of his disciples, in parallel with the diakonos; in O.T. usage the corresponding word was the title of honored royal officials, the Servant of the Lord, etc. "For a slave has no understanding of what his owner is doing" in the normal course of things the slave is not admitted to the counsels of his master, he simply obeys. "I have called you beloved" this term which Christ has used is far more in keeping with the state of Christians, which is to offer a loving obedience that is their part in the common life they share; The Christian hears the Son, even as the Son has heard the Father. The divine initiative has been paramount throughout this history of salvation. The Son was sent by the Father, and the Son has chosen his own, whose mission and whose life, therefore, continue a work of divine grace.

EL SEXTO DOMINGO DE PASCUA

El Mandamiento de Amor.

La figura de la vid y las ramas en Juan invita a la comparación con la doctrina Paulina de Cristo la cabeza de su cuerpo la iglesia. La idea de Pauline sin embargo se desarrolla lejos; Aunque el Evangelio de Juan se terminó mucho después de las epístolas paulinas, Juan es fiel a la edad histórica en la que se establece el Evangelio y, por lo tanto, no desarrolla la figura más allá de la aplicación que le ha dado Jesús. El amor es el principio de la relación entre el padre y el hijo; el mismo amor ha llevado a la iglesia a ser "permanezca en mi amor". Los discípulos deben continuar para mantenerse dignos de la protección del amor de Cristo. Esto se hace por obediencia a la voluntad de Cristo, otra vez siguiendo su ejemplo. "nadie puede tener mayor amor", el amor cristiano tiene como modelo nada menos que el ejemplo del buen pastor; a su vez, el amor de Cristo le da al cristiano la capacidad de estar a la altura de este ideal. "ya no llamo a los esclavos", no había nada degradante en sido conocido como el esclavo de Dios o un buen maestro; Jesús usa el término esclavo (Doulos) de sus discípulos, en paralelo con los diakonos; en O.T. uso la palabra correspondiente era el título de los funcionarios reales honrados, el siervo del Señor, etc. "porque un esclavo no entiende lo que su dueño está haciendo" en el curso normal de las cosas el esclavo no es admitido a los consejos de su amo, él simplemente obedece. "te he llamado amado" este término que Cristo ha utilizado es mucho más acorde con el estado de los cristianos, que es ofrecer una obediencia amorosa que es su parte en la vida común que comparten; El cristiano escucha al hijo, así como el hijo ha oído al padre. La iniciativa divina ha sido primordial a lo largo de esta historia de salvación. El hijo fue enviado por el padre, y el hijo ha elegido el suyo, cuya misión y cuya vida, por lo tanto, continúan una obra de gracia divina.
