Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

At Passover time Jesus multiplies the loaves and fish and gives a discourse on the Bread of Life. There are two Synoptic accounts of the multiplication, followed in the first instance by the walking on the sea; and charts show in some details John's account seems closer to the first Synoptic account and in other details closer to the second Synoptic account. The introduction of Philip and Andrew as characters who prepare for Jesus' response is typically Johannine; and John has peculiar features that could heighten the Eucharistic symbolism in the multiplication. The combination of marvelously supplied food and walking on the water echoed Moses' miracles in the Exodus after the first Passover, manna, Red Sea, even as the murmuring of 6:41 matches the similar action of Israel in the desert wandering. Accordingly a comparison of Jesus and Moses follows: Moses did not give the true bread from heaven because those who ate the manna died. Whereas the Synoptic account do not tell us the reaction of those for whom the bread and fish were multiplied, John has the crowd find and put demands on Jesus the next day as evidence that they did not really see beyond the miraculous to what was signified. Jesus did not come simply to satisfy earthly hunger but to give a bread that should nourish people for eternal life, and the discourse that follows seems to give two interpretations of how this would be done.

Decimoséptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

En el tiempo de la Pascua, Jesús multiplica los panes y los peces y da un discurso sobre el pan de la vida. Hay dos relatos sinópticos de la multiplicación, seguidos en primera instancia por el caminar sobre el mar; y los cuadros muestran algunos detalles La cuenta de Juan parece más cercana a la primera cuenta sinóptica y en otros detalles más cerca de la segunda cuenta sinóptica. La introducción de Felipe y Andrés como personajes que se preparan para la respuesta de Jesús es típicamente joánicos; y Juan tiene rasgos peculiares que podrían acentuar el simbolismo Eucarístico en la multiplicación. La combinación de comida maravillosamente provista y caminar sobre el agua hizo eco de los milagros de Moisés en el Éxodo después de la primera Pascua, maná, Mar Rojo, incluso cuando el murmullo de 6:41 coincide con la acción similar de Israel en el desierto vagando. En consecuencia, sigue una comparación de Jesús y Moisés: Moisés no dio el verdadero pan del cielo porque los que comieron el maná murieron. Mientras que el relato sinóptico no nos dice la reacción de aquellos para quienes el pan y el pescado se multiplicaron, Juan hizo que la multitud encontrara y exigiera a Jesús al día siguiente como evidencia de que realmente no vieron más allá de lo milagroso a lo que se significaba. Jesús no vino simplemente para satisfacer el hambre terrenal, sino para dar un pan que debe alimentar a las personas para la vida eterna, y el discurso que sigue parece dar dos interpretaciones de cómo se haría.
