Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

After the abortive attempt to proclaim Jesus a Jewish Messiah, we may suppose that the more tenacious of the crowd continued to seek out his whereabouts. They knew he had not departed with the disciples, yet they could not find him on their side of the lake; therefore they proceeded to Capernaum where he and his disciples were known to resort. The crowd is naturally curious about his coming to this place. So his disciples and Nicodemus had begun their first conversations with Jesus, with somewhat disparate result; the result here will again be different. Jesus does not answer their question: To reveal another miracle to them would have produced just the opposite effect from the one he intended. Rather he will tell them of his coming that really matters, "not because you have seen signs". Jesus means that they have not perceived the true meaning of the signs. The people have considered only the material aspect of the miracle and have failed to reflect on its significance. The discourse begins with the announcement of the theme. Using a metaphor, bread=doctrine, whose meaning should have been recognized, Jesus attempts to raise their minds from purely earthly concerns to that which leads to eternal life; for this he says they should be working even as they work for earthly bread.

The people have understood only that he speaks of a miraculous food that will not perish, obviously a work of God. Work he has said. Very well, how are they to perform a work of God? God's work they cannot really do; their task is to accept him in faith. Only in this need their working consist. Another misunderstanding follows. The people think that they are being asked to put faith in Jesus merely to credit something he is about to say.

Decimoctavo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Después del abortado intento de proclamar a Jesús como un Mesías judío, podemos suponer que los más tenaces de la multitud continuaron buscando su paradero. Sabían que no se había ido con los discípulos, pero no podían encontrarlo en su lado del lago; por lo tanto, se dirigieron a Capernaum, donde él y sus discípulos eran conocidos por recurrir. La multitud es curiosa por naturaleza acerca de su visita a este lugar. Entonces sus discípulos y Nicodemo habían comenzado sus primeras conversaciones con Jesús, con un resultado algo dispar; el resultado aquí será de nuevo diferente. Jesús no responde su pregunta: revelarles otro milagro habría producido el efecto opuesto al que él pretendía. Más bien les dirá de su llegada que realmente importa, "no porque hayas visto señales". Jesús quiere decir que no han percibido el verdadero significado de los signos. Las personas solo han considerado el aspecto material del milagro y no han podido reflexionar sobre su significado. El discurso comienza con la anunciación del tema. Usando una metáfora, pan = doctrina, cuyo significado debería haber sido reconocido, Jesús intenta elevar sus mentes de preocupaciones puramente terrenales a lo que conduce a la vida eterna; por esto dice que deberían estar trabajando incluso mientras trabajan para el pan terrenal.

La gente solo ha entendido que habla de un alimento milagroso que no perecerá, obviamente una obra de Dios. El trabajo que él ha dicho. Muy bien, ¿cómo van a realizar una obra de Dios? El trabajo de Dios que realmente no pueden hacer; su tarea es aceptarlo en la fe. Solo en esta necesidad, su trabajo consiste. Otro malentendido sigue. La gente piensa que se les pide que depositen su fe en Jesús simplemente para dar crédito a algo que él va a decir.
