**Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time.**

The second part of Jesus discourse has been rejected by some scholars as another ecclesiastical interpretation. Their theory is based on the assumption that John would not have been interested in a sacramental doctrine. However the doctrine is closely connected with what has preceded. It now becomes clear how Jesus is a living bread that may and must be eaten so that men have life. Give for the life of the world: this passage echoes the logion reported by Paul in 1 Cor.11:24 and there should be little doubt that it intends to connect the Eucharist with the redemptive death of Christ as is done in the Synoptics and by Paul.

It is to be noted that John cites Jesus as using the word "flesh", whereas in Paul and the Synoptic tradition the Eucharistic term is "body". Here we doubtless have another instance of John's adherence to a more primitive account of the facts. John's "flesh" probably reproduces the actual word that would have been used by Jesus, a word that serves in the Semitic languages to signify both flesh and living body, whereas the Synoptic and Pauline term represents a later semantic development in Christian terminology, which profited from the greater potentialities of the Greek word "soma".

**Vigésimo Domingo en el tiempo ordinario**

La segunda parte del discurso de Jesús ha sido rechazada por algunos eruditos como otra interpretación eclesiástica. Su teoría se basa en la suposición de que Juan no habría estado interesado en una doctrina sacramental. Sin embargo, la doctrina está estrechamente relacionada con lo que ha precedido. Ahora se aclara cómo Jesús es un pan vivo que puede y debe ser comido para que los hombres tengan vida. Dar por la vida del mundo: este pasaje hace eco de la logion reportada por Pablo en 1 Cor. 11:24 y no debe haber alguna duda de que tiene la intención de conectar la Eucaristía con la muerte redentora de Cristo como se hace en los sinópticos y por Pablo.

Hay que notar que Juan cita a Jesús como la utilización de la palabra "carne", mientras que en Pablo y la tradición Sinóptica el término Eucarístico es "el cuerpo". Aquí sin duda tenemos otro caso de la adhesión de Juan a una cuenta más primitiva de los hechos. La "carne" de Juan probablemente reproduzca la palabra real que habría sido utilizada por Jesús, una palabra que sirva en las lenguas semíticas para significar la carne y el cuerpo vivo, mientras que el término sinóptico y Paulino representa un desarrollo semántico posterior en terminología cristiano, que se benefició de las mayores potencialidades de la palabra griega "Soma".
