The Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

The journey to Judea, instructing the crowds, and a question of the Pharisees are the context for Jesus' teaching on marriage and divorce. The Pharisees on the basis of the book of Deuteronomy would allow a husband to write out a note divorcing his wife because of "an indecency in her", and rabbis debated whether that indecency had to be something very serious or could be trivial. But Jesus, appealing to Genesis 1:27 for the unity created by marriage, would forbid breaking the marriage bond, so that remarriage after a divorce constitutes adultery. A same attitude is found among the Jews who produced the Dead Sea Scrolls. A form of the prohibition is preserved in Matthew twice, Luke and 1 Corinthians; and so it is not unlikely that historically there was a controversy in Jesus' life between him and other Jews who held different views about the issue. The difficulty of his position was recognized by early Christians, and the saying soon gathered comments. For instance, Mark, which extends the statement to a wife divorcing her husband, not a practice envisioned in OT law, is probably an adaptation to the situation of the Gentile hearers of the Gospel where women could divorce men.

El Vigésimo Séptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

El viaje a Judea, instruir a las multitudes, y una cuestión de los fariseos, son el contexto de la enseñanza de Jesús sobre el matrimonio y el divorcio. Los fariseos sobre la base del libro de Deuteronomio permitirían a un esposo escribir una nota divorciando a su esposa debido a "una indecencia en ella", y los rabinos debatieron si esa indecencia tenía que ser algo muy serio o podría ser trivial. Pero Jesús, apelando a Génesis 1:27 por la unidad creada por el matrimonio, prohibiría romper el vínculo matrimonial, para que el nuevo matrimonio después de un divorcio constituya adulterio. Una misma actitud se encuentra entre los judíos que produjeron los pergaminos del mar muerto. Una forma de la prohibición se preserva en Mateo dos veces, Lucas y 1 Corintios; así que no es improbable que históricamente haya habido una controversia en la vida de Jesús entre él y otros judíos que tenían diferentes puntos de vista sobre el tema. La dificultad de su posición fue reconocida por los primeros cristianos, y el refrán pronto recogió Comentarios. Por ejemplo, Marcos, que extiende la declaración a una esposa que se divorcie de su marido, no una práctica que se prevé en la ley de OT, es probablemente una adaptación a la situación de los odores gentiles del Evangelio donde las mujeres pueden divorciarse de los hombres.
