The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the initial Cana miracle, when John calls a sign, Jesus replaces the water prescribed for Jewish purifications, in stone jars containing more than 120 gallons, by wine so good that the headwaiter wonders why the best has been kept until last. This represents the revelation and wisdom that he brings from God, fulfilling the OT promises of abundance of wine in the messianic days. And intertwined motif involves the mother of Jesus, whose family style request on behalf of the newly married "they have no wine" is rebuffed by Jesus on the grounds that his hour had not yet come. Yet the mother's persistence wins his request after a rebuff. The mother of Jesus will reappear at the foot of the cross, where her incorporation into discipleship will be completed as she becomes the mother of the Beloved Disciple. Meanwhile in a transitional verse we find that she and Jesus' brothers followed him to Capernaum, but no farther when he began his public ministry by going to Jerusalem.

El Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

En el milagro inicial de Caná, cuando Juan llama a una señal, Jesús reemplaza el agua prescrita para las purificaciones judías, en frascos de piedra que contienen más de 120 galones, por un vino tan bueno que el jefe de cabecera se pregunta por qué lo mejor se ha mantenido hasta el final. Esto representa la revelación y la sabiduría que trae de Dios, cumpliendo las promesas de abundancia de vino del AT en los días mesiánicos. Y el motivo entrelazado involucra a la madre de Jesús, cuya petición de estilo familiar en nombre de los recién casados "no tienen vino" es rechazada por Jesús sobre la base de que su hora aún no había llegado. Sin embargo, la persistencia de la madre gana su petición después de un rechazo. La madre de Jesús reaparecerá al pie de la cruz, donde se completará su incorporación al discipulado cuando se convierta en la madre del Discípulo Amado. Mientras tanto, en un verso de transición, encontramos que ella y los hermanos de Jesús lo siguieron a Capernaum, pero no más lejos cuando comenzó su ministerio público yendo a Jerusalem.
