Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The motivation of the Pharisees and the Herodians in questioning Jesus about the legality of paying taxes to Cesar was quickly exposed by Jesus' response: "Render therefore to Caesar the things that are the Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's". As citizens of the empire, they owed the emperor allegiance but, first and foremost, they owed God allegiance, for there is no authority except from God.

As adopted children of our heavenly Father, we are citizens of a heavenly kingdom. We are called and chosen to be a holy people, set apart for God's praise and glory. The Father wants us to share his divine life now as well as in eternity, to develop and intimacy of relationship with him through his word. We are gifted with the high dignity of being made of God's image and likeness. We have received a privileged citizenship and, a call to extend God's kingdom on earth.

This is way, even as a people set apart, we need to see the importance of public affairs. The fathers of the Second Vatican Council taught: The Church regards as worthy of praise and consideration the work of those who, as a service to others, dedicate themselves to the welfare of the state and undertake the burdens of this task. Followers of Christ are called to bring an authentic Christian voice to governmental and political affairs.

The Christian life is not set in opposition to civil life. As a result of our first parent's decision to usurp God's authority, obedience to authority, whatever its nature, goes against our desire for independence. Even so, Jesus died that all people might acknowledge God's authority in their lives. By appropriating his power and that of his cross, the desires of our fallen nature can be overcome; by our witness of obedience, God's kingdom can come and reign among us. God's plan for our lives far exceeds our imagining. His plan includes obedience to the laws of governing authorities, and God's plan will not be thwarted. The prophet Isaiah recognized Cyrus of Persia, as God's instrument for fulfilling his plan for the Jews to be returned from exile in Babylon to restore Jerusalem and its temple.

Vigésimo-Noveno Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

La motivación de los fariseos y herodianos al cuestionar a Jesús sobre la legalidad del pago de impuestos al César quedó rápidamente expuesta por la respuesta de Jesús: "Dad, pues, al César lo que es del César y a Dios lo que es de Dios". Como ciudadanos del imperio, le debían lealtad al emperador pero, ante todo, le debían lealtad a Dios, porque no hay autoridad excepto de Dios.

Como hijos adoptivos de nuestro Padre celestial, somos ciudadanos de un reino celestial. Somos llamados y elegidos para ser un pueblo santo, apartado para la alabanza y la gloria de Dios. El Padre quiere que compartamos su vida divina tanto ahora como en la eternidad, para desarrollar una relación íntima con él a través de su palabra. Estamos dotados de la gran dignidad de estar hechos a imagen y semejanza de Dios. Hemos recibido una ciudadanía privilegiada y un llamado a extender el reino de Dios en la tierra.

Así es como, incluso como pueblo apartado, necesitamos ver la importancia de los asuntos públicos. Los padres del Concilio Vaticano II enseñaron: La Iglesia considera digno de alabanza y consideración el trabajo de quienes, como servicio a los demás, se dedican al bienestar del Estado y asumen las cargas de esta tarea. Los seguidores de Cristo están llamados a traer una auténtica voz cristiana a los asuntos gubernamentales y políticos.

La vida cristiana no se opone a la vida civil. Como resultado de la decisión de nuestro primer padre de usurpar la autoridad de Dios, la obediencia a la autoridad, cualquiera que sea su naturaleza, va en contra de nuestro deseo de independencia. Aun así, Jesús murió para que todas las personas pudieran reconocer la autoridad de Dios en sus vidas. Al apropiarse de su poder y el de su cruz, los deseos de nuestra naturaleza caída se pueden vencer; por nuestro testimonio de obediencia, el reino de Dios puede venir y reinar entre nosotros. El plan de Dios para nuestras vidas supera con creces nuestra imaginación. Su plan incluye la obediencia a las leyes de las autoridades gobernantes, y el plan de Dios no se verá frustrado. El profeta Isaías reconoció a Ciro de Persia como un instrumento de Dios para cumplir su plan de que los judíos regresaran del exilio en Babilonia para restaurar Jerusalén y su templo.

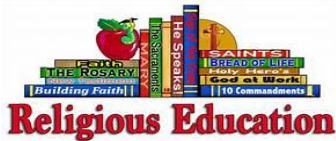
