The Third Sunday of Easter

What an astounding turn of events! The man whom the disciples had followed for three years and with whom had traveled all over Palestine, the one they saw die on the cross, stood before them and told them that God had raised him from death. It is no wonder their lives were turned upside down. Could you be the same if this happened to you?

To assure them that his death was no accident, Jesus opened the disciples' minds to understand how everything written in the Hebrew scriptures pointed to him and was fulfilled in him. From first to last, Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of everything God has spoken to his creation. Throughout history, God was working meticulously, preparing for the moment when his Son would come to earth to win our forgiveness. Each prayer and wise saying, is part of an intricate mosaic that reveals another aspect of our Triune God and his love for his people. From the very start, God has been speaking to us about his Son, drawing us in so many ways to embrace the life that Jesus came to give us.

Even today, 2000 years after the resurrection, Jesus remain the summation of God's words to us. The Gospels are filled with stories of encounters with the Risen Lord to show us that we too can know Jesus Christ, risen from the dead. Jesus not simply ascend to heaven, there to remain hidden until the second coming. He rose in glory, and he wants to share the hope and joy of his resurrection with all his people. He wants us all to receive his divine life, to know a life that is victorious over sin and death.

Just as Jesus opened the disciples' minds to see him in scripture, he wants to do the same for us. We can experience his love and presence as we ponder his words with a quiet heart. God wants to show us that it is has always been his desire and plan to give up his only Son so that we could be reconciled to God and share in his divine life.

Tercer Domingo De Pascua

¡Qué giro tan asombroso de los acontecimientos! El hombre a quien los discípulos habían seguido durante tres años y con quien había viajado por toda Palestina, el que vieron morir en la cruz, se paró ante ellos y les dijo que Dios lo había resucitado de la muerte. No es de extrañar que sus vidas hayan dado un vuelco. ¿Podrías ser el mismo si esto te sucediera?

Para asegurarles que su muerte no fue un accidente, Jesús abrió la mente de los discípulos para que entendieran cómo todo lo escrito en las escrituras hebreas apuntaba a él y se cumplía en él. De principio a fin, Jesucristo es el cumplimiento de todo lo que Dios le ha dicho a su creación. A lo largo de la historia, Dios trabajó meticulosamente, preparándose para el momento en que su Hijo vendría a la tierra para ganar nuestro perdón. Cada oración y dicho sabio es parte de un intrincado mosaico que revela otro aspecto de nuestro Dios Uno y Trino y su amor por su pueblo. Desde el principio, Dios nos ha estado hablando de su Hijo, atrayéndonos de muchas maneras a abrazar la vida que Jesús vino a darnos.

Incluso hoy, 2000 años después de la resurrección, Jesús sigue siendo el resumen de las palabras de Dios para nosotros. Los Evangelios están llenos de historias de encuentros con el Señor Resucitado para mostrarnos que también nosotros podemos conocer a Jesucristo, resucitado de entre los muertos. Jesús no simplemente asciende al cielo, para permanecer oculto hasta la segunda venida. Resucitó en gloria y quiere compartir la esperanza y el gozo de su resurrección con todo su pueblo. Quiere que todos recibamos su vida divina, que conozcamos una vida victoriosa sobre el pecado y la muerte.

Así como Jesús abrió la mente de los discípulos para que lo vieran en las Escrituras, él quiere hacer lo mismo por nosotros. Podemos experimentar su amor y presencia al meditar en sus palabras con un corazón tranquilo. Dios quiere mostrarnos que siempre ha sido su deseo y plan entregar a su único Hijo para que podamos reconciliarnos con Dios y compartir su vida divina.
