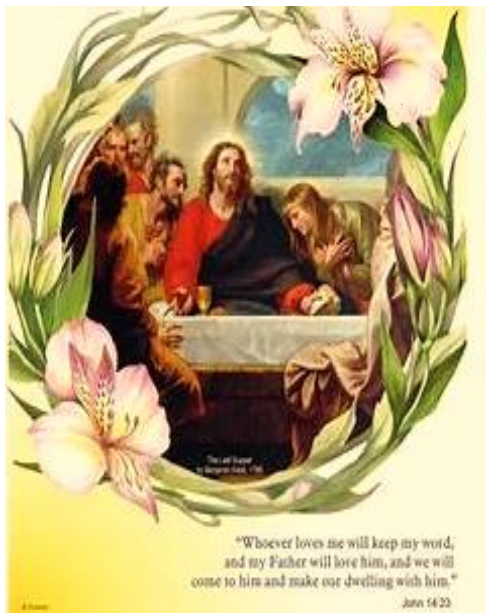

The miracle of love is that God himself is love. Love is not something he says or does, it is the very essence of who he is. All the other characteristics of God are but extensions of his love. God is all-knowing, all-powerful, just and merciful, because he is love.

The grasp the love that God has for us, it is essential to understand, that love the Father has for his Son, for it is the same love. God's love for his Son is eternal; it neither began with the incarnation of Christ, nor ended with his resurrection. Jesus was with the Father from the beginning and is the first object of his love. Therefore, when Jesus tells us he loves us just as the Father loves him, it is not restricted to space and time, it is as everlasting as God himself.

Jesus loves us with a love that gives everything it possesses and keeps nothing for itself. The Father and the Son are one in that love. All that the Father is and has, he has given to Jesus. As with the Father, Jesus gave himself totally for the sake of love. He did not consider even his life or his body too much to give for us. And in a manner that surpasses understanding, he made himself one with his Church, the body of Christ. He will never leave us. He will never abandon his Church.

Jesus loves us with a tender, covenant love. He is not deterred by our sins and failings because his love is greater than our fickle hearts. He envelops our fallibility, our slow growth, and our many fears with gentle compassion and continues to work in our hearts. He is fully committed to us and will never stop offering us opportunities to grow closer to him and receive his love more fully.

When the love of Jesus touches our hearts, it melts the hardness and produces in us a love for him. We begin to long for him so much that we want to obey his commandments because we know that obedience to his word will further our growth in the knowledge of his love. We begin to see with spiritual eyes that his will and his ways are far greater than our ideas and wishes.

Sexto Domingo De Pascua

El milagro del amor es que Dios mismo es amor. El amor no es algo que él dice o hace, es la esencia misma de quién es. Todas las demás características de Dios no son más que extensiones de su amor. Dios es omnisciente, omnipotente, justo y misericordioso, porque es amor.

La captación del amor que Dios tiene por nosotros, es fundamental comprender, que el amor que el Padre tiene por su Hijo, porque es el mismo amor. El amor de Dios por su Hijo es eterno; no comenzó con la encarnación de Cristo ni terminó con su resurrección. Jesús estuvo con el Padre desde el principio y es el primer objeto de su amor. Por lo tanto, cuando Jesús nos dice que nos ama tal como el Padre lo ama a él, no está restringido al espacio y al tiempo, es tan eterno como Dios mismo.

Jesús nos ama con un amor que da todo lo que posee y no guarda nada para sí mismo. El Padre y el Hijo son uno en ese amor. Todo lo que el Padre es y tiene, se lo ha dado a Jesús. Al igual que el Padre, Jesús se entregó totalmente por amor. Ni siquiera consideró su vida o su cuerpo demasiado para dar por nosotros. Y de una manera que sobrepasa la comprensión, se hizo uno con su Iglesia, el cuerpo de Cristo. Él nunca nos dejará. Nunca abandonará su Iglesia.

Jesús nos ama con un amor tierno y de pacto. No se deja disuadir por nuestros pecados y fallas porque su amor es mayor que nuestros corazones volubles. Él envuelve nuestra falibilidad, nuestro lento crecimiento y nuestros muchos miedos con tierna compasión y continúa trabajando en nuestros corazones. Está totalmente comprometido con nosotros y nunca dejará de ofrecernos oportunidades para acercarnos a él y recibir su amor más plenamente.

Cuando el amor de Jesús toca nuestros corazones, derrite la dureza y produce en nosotros un amor por él. Comenzamos a anhelarlo tanto que deseamos obedecer sus mandamientos porque sabemos que la obediencia a su palabra promoverá nuestro crecimiento en el conocimiento de su amor. Comenzamos a ver con ojos espirituales que su voluntad y sus caminos son mucho más grandes que nuestras ideas y deseos.

Today's Gospel John 15:9-17

Jesus commands his disciples to love one another. Jesus reminds his disciples that this knowledge is to be expressed in love. Those who know Jesus well—and Jesus says that his disciples do know him—will love one another. Knowledge leads to love, which leads to action. John reminds his community that Jesus taught that love is the sign of a true disciple and, thus, a true Christian. Even more, a true disciple shows a particular kind of love, sacrificial love.
