- Limited ministry is needed, (lectors, ushers, and sacristans).
- Ushers will assist parishioners with seating. Additional seating will be available in the parish hall to allow required social distancing.
- Collection baskets will be placed in the entries of the church. (Collection will not be taken by the ushers).
- Sacristans will prepare hosts, and wine ONLY for the pastor. (Precious body will be distributed ONLY by the pastor.)
- Holy Communion will be given only in the hand; practice safe distancing when coming up to receive.
- No hospitality or visiting in the church after services.

ASCENSION OF OUR LORD



This Sunday, we celebrate the feast of the Ascension, when Jesus ascended into Heaven. For forty days, Jesus stayed with the apostles and continued to teach and guide them for what was to come; he prepared them for their missions of evangelization and the crosses that they would bear, including suffering and dying for the faith. At the end of the forty days, Jesus was taken back to Heaven. As we remember Jesus' Ascension, let us begin to look forward to the feast of the Pentecost, which is just ten days after the feast of the Ascension, and it is regarded as

the birthday of the Church. On the feast of the Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and filled them with the graces and strengths needed to make them strong soldiers for Christ. This happens to us, in the sacrament of Confirmation, when we receive the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit which strengthen us and fortifies the three theological gifts that we already received in the sacrament of Baptism.
