THE PRAYER CHAIN AND THE PRAYER CARD MINISTRIES REQUIRE LITTLE OF YOUR TIME

The Prayer Chain Ministry consists of a group of dedicated parishioners who are committed to pray for others' prayer intentions for a period of time.

The Prayer Card Ministry consists of a group of individuals who will send out a card to a specific family to let them know we remember them. The minister will pray for them during the week the card is sent out.

These wonderful and rewarding ministries have no meetings, no special skills, and do not require any particular place to be involved.

If you feel called to join the Prayer Chain or Prayer Card ministry, but aren't sure where to start in prayer - don't worry; you will be guided in different forms of prayer.



Prayer Chain Ministry of St. Thomas the Apostle welcomes all who would like to serve God through prayer. Prayer warriors are invited to pray daily for the prayer requests submitted by our fellow parishioners, their family, friends, and our community.

How to Get Involved: If you would like to become a member of the Prayer Chain, we welcome you! The purpose is to provide spiritual support through the power of intercessory prayer. The Prayer Chain offers an opportunity to serve God by uniting in prayer for those in need. This is all done from your home. Members pray individually for each person who submits a prayer request to the parish.

Who Can Participate: Everyone can participate, including stay at home moms/dads, the homebound, entire families, etc. The prayer chain communications will be email based, so an active email address is required. Maintaining confidentiality is essential while serving as a prayer warrior.

Prayer Card Ministry of St. Thomas the Apostle Prayer is our primary vehicle for communicating with God. At our parish we desire to pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ and their intentions. In this fast-paced world of emails and texts, receiving a card is special and heartwarming. Perhaps the card is received when a family needs prayer or when a prayer is answered. For whatever occasion, the volunteers for this card ministry seek to keep our parish family members feeling connected throughout the year.

How to Get Involved: Volunteers in this ministry will share God's love by sending cards. The minister will commit to pray for one person or one family at a time. This is all done from your home. Praying for others strengthens relationships, both with each other and with God. It is a beautiful spiritual gift to share.
