## Prayers to the Holy Spirit

One of my greatest devotions is to the Holy Spirit, because even though He seems to be one of the most neglected Persons of the Blessed Trinity, His power is more evident than we might think. In fact, once Jesus ascended the Holy Spirit descended, filling the Apostles with a strength they had never known before, creating, in its wake, a much different Church than the one that existed when Christ was there. St. Peter not only became the representative for the group, he embraced being crucified, despite the constant fear he had of it when Jesus was with him. What's more, is that the same Apostles who fled to the Upper Room, left that room confident and unafraid of the consequences of spreading the Gospel. Given that, I want to share with you some of my favorite prayers to the Holy Spirit, especially as we honor Him today on this great Feast of Pentecost and the birthday of the Church. Fr. Brian

This first prayer is one of my favorite prayers to the Holy Spirit. It was written by St. Augustine and it is a prayer I pray everyday.

*Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit  
That my thoughts may all be holy.  
Act in me, O Holy Spirit  
That my work too may be holy.  
Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit  
That I love but what is holy.  
Strengthen me O Holy Spirit  
To defend all that is holy.  
Guard me then, O Holy Spirit  
That I always may be holy.  
Amen.*

This next prayer was written Pope St. Pius X and it is a consecration to the Holy Spirit.

*O Holy Spirit, divine Spirit of light and love. I consecrate to You my understanding, my heart and my will, my whole being for time and for eternity.*

*May my understanding be always submissive to Your heavenly inspirations and to the teachings of the Holy Catholic Church, of which You are the infallible Guide.*

*May my heart be ever inflamed with love of God and of my neighbor; may my will be ever conformed to the divine Will, and may my whole life be a faithful imitation of the life and virtues of Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, to whom with the Father and You, Holy Spirit, be honor and glory forever. Amen.*

This last prayer is by Cardinal Merciar, he called this prayer his secret to sanctity and happiness.

*O Holy Spirit, beloved of my soul, I adore You. Enlighten me, guide me, strengthen me, console me. Tell me what I should do; give me Your orders. I promise to submit myself to all that You desire of me and to accept all that You permit to happen to me. Let me only know Your Will. Amen.*

Illness or Impending Surgery**

Hospitals are required to observe confidentiality and privacy laws and are no longer able to inform parishes of admissions of parishioners. It is now necessary for either the patient, him/her self, or a family member to notify the parish of his/her hospitalization. Arrangements then can be made for the parish priest to visit the patient.

Because of privacy laws we do not publish the names of the sick in our bulletin or announce them at Mass unless the patient or a family member gives us permission to do so.
