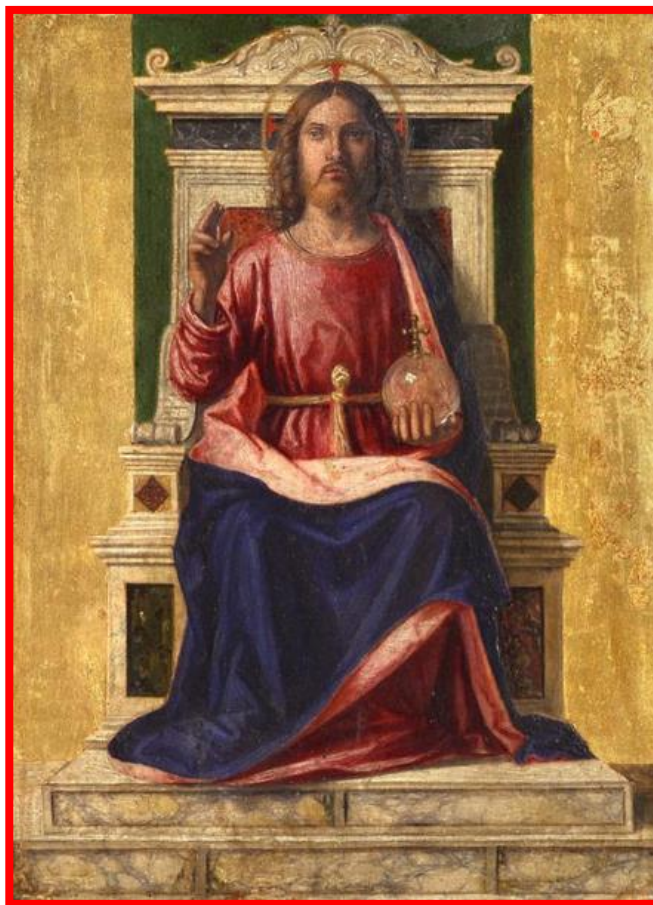

### Sacramental Life

#### Baptism

To have a child baptized, parents must register and attend a class as a couple. Try to attend before your child is born. At least one parent and godparent must be practicing Catholics. Please call or email the church office for information or to register.

#### Confession

The priest is available for Penance at St. Bernadette on Saturday at 3 PM and Thursday at 5:30 PM, and at St. Mary Bremen on Sunday at 8 AM. First Saturday Confessions are held at 8:30 AM at St. Bernadette. Every Catholic priest is available whenever there is a need.

#### Anointing and Care of the Sick

The priest gives the Anointing of the Sick to one who is dangerously ill, facing major surgery, or suffering from the ravages of old age. Call the parish office before a hospitalization or when it has been too long since the Sacraments were last available.

#### Holy Matrimony

Couples wishing to marry should contact the parish office six months before a wedding. Why so long? Because this Sacrament, not just the ceremony, requires serious preparation. And the Church needs to be involved in that preparation. The Church needs to support couples through the years of married life and offers programs to enhance married life. To learn about these programs, watch the bulletin.

#### Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration takes place each Wednesday at St. Bernadette with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 9 AM and Benediction and Reposition at 1 PM. All are welcome and encouraged to come.

The altar servers did great debuting their new gear. All the ritual details of Mass had a practical origin. Bells get people's attention at the important parts. Candles light the altar to read the liturgical books. Incense is a Glade Plug-In before they got popular. Later they took on traditional spiritual significance. We are glad to re-discover some of these riches.

Coinciding with a new liturgical schedule beginning next week, a couple small adjustments: Holy Communion will be only given in the Host and exchanging the Sign of Peace will be omitted. With flu season here, these are prudential measures of permitted options to minimize sickness for all.

For those with serious gluten issues, please give us a call so we can provide a solution suitable for you. By going to the priest celebrant, a low-gluten Host is always available. It's a good reminder that in every drop or crumb of the Consecrated Species, the whole Christ is present, so we take most diligent care of the vessels and linens for Mass. Receiving the Holy Eucharist should be the highlight of our week, marked with the most sincere reverence and devotion we have.

We have a small stretch of November left to pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. Don't forget to ask them to pray for you, too! If you haven't made your cemetery visits, there's still time.
