Sacramental Life

Baptism

To have a child baptized, parents must register and attend a class as a couple. Try to attend before your child is born. At least one parent and godparent must be practicing Catholics. Please call or email the church office for information or to register.

Confession

The priest is available for Penance at St. Bernadette on Saturday at 3 PM and Thursday at 5:30 PM, and at St. Mary Bremen on Sunday at 8 AM. First Saturday Confessions are held at 8:30 AM at St. Bernadette. Every Catholic priest is available whenever there is a need.

Anointing and Care of the Sick

The priest gives the Anointing of the Sick to one who is dangerously ill, facing major surgery, or suffering from the ravages of old age. Call the parish office before a hospitalization or when it has been too long since the Sacraments were last available.

Holy Matrimony

Couples wishing to marry should contact the parish office six months before a wedding. Why so long? Because this Sacrament, not just the ceremony, requires serious preparation. And the Church needs to be involved in that preparation. The Church needs to support couples through the years of married life and offers programs to enhance married life. To learn about these programs, watch the bulletin.

Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration takes place each Wednesday at St. Bernadette with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 9 AM and Benediction and Reposition at 1 PM. All are welcome and encouraged to come.

Happy New Year! Advent begins another liturgical cycle, Year C. Although not as rigorous as Lent, this season still has penitential qualities in preparation for the Solemnity of Christmas. A modest fast/sacrifice and coordinating commitment of increased prayer would be well placed. As best as we can, it is ideal to try to keep the Christmas celebrations for Christmas and respect the integrity of this Advent season. See below and plan for your Advent confession.

Saturday is not just a Holy Day of Obligation; it is very special to us because the Immaculate Conception is both our nation's patronal feast day and connected also to our Patroness, St. Bernadette. Masses will be at 6:00 PM on Friday and 9:00 AM on Saturday at St. Bernadette and at NOON in Bremen. Although we've been having Saturday morning Masses in the Extraordinary Form, these will be regular Ordinary Form parish Masses.

The omission of the optional exchange of peace and distributing the Precious Blood will help to cut down on germs this flu season. If you have problems receiving the low-gluten Hosts, please let us know so that accommodations can be made.
