### Sacramental Life

#### Baptism

To have a child baptized, parents must register and attend a class as a couple. Try to attend before your child is born. At least one parent and godparent must be practicing Catholics. Please call or email the church office for information or to register.

#### Confession

The priest is available for Penance at St. Bernadette on Saturdays at 8:30 AM and 3 PM, and on Thursdays at 5:30 PM. Confessions are held at St. Mary Bremen on Sunday at 8 AM. Every Catholic priest is available whenever there is a need.

#### Anointing and Care of the Sick

The priest gives the Anointing of the Sick to one who is dangerously ill, facing major surgery, or suffering from the ravages of old age. Call the parish office to inform us if a loved one is in need of pastoral care in sickness, particularly with an extended absence from attending Mass.

#### Holy Matrimony

Couples wishing to marry should contact the parish office six months before a wedding. Why so long? Because this Sacrament, not just the ceremony, requires serious preparation. And the Church needs to be involved in that preparation. The Church needs to support couples through the years of married life and offers programs to enhance married life. To learn about these programs, watch the bulletin.

#### Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration takes place each Wednesday at St. Bernadette with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 9 AM and Benediction and Reposition at 1 PM. All are welcome and encouraged to come.

### Collar Corner

Happy Feast of Corpus Christi! The Most Holy Eucharist is of course the centerpiece of Catholicism, the source and summit of our Faith. Here are some reflections on receiving the Blessed Sacrament more devoutly.

As the person in front of you approaches, bow your head in a gesture of adoration. For most of Church history, Communion was distributed directly on the tongue only. If you've never received that way, it's worth a try, particularly for those whose hands are full wrangling children or if you have mobility or balance issues. It's also a great traditional sign of reverence for the Sacrament. If you do receive in the hand, make sure it is clean, flat, and steady, never grabbing or walking away too soon. This time of year especially, humidity can make the Host stick and increase the danger of being dropped greatly. While accidents can happen, we should be as careful as possible. Upon returning to the pew, kneel to make a prayer of thanksgiving, which is what the word "Eucharist" means. Staying after Mass and preserving a spirit of quiet prayer in the church before and after are spiritually helpful practices to enter into the prayer of the Mass well.

Also, everyone can step up the game of how we dress by a notch. It's tempting in the summer-time to get more casual. Make extra effort for feast days and the special seasons. Above all, be in the state of grace. If you have committed even a single serious sin like skipping Mass or getting drunk, that needs to be brought to Confession before receiving. Never forget, it is the Body of Christ!
