Sacramental Life

Baptism

To have a child baptized, parents must register and attend a class as a couple. Try to attend before your child is born. At least one parent and godparent must be practicing Catholics. Please call or email the church office for information or to register.

Confession

The priest is available for Penance at St. Bernadette on Saturdays at 8:30 AM and 3 PM, and on Thursdays at 5:30 PM. Confessions are held at St. Mary Bremen on Sunday at 8 AM. Every Catholic priest is available whenever there is a need.

Anointing and Care of the Sick

The priest gives the Anointing of the Sick to one who is dangerously ill, facing major surgery, or suffering from the ravages of old age. Call the parish office to inform us if a loved one is in need of pastoral care in sickness, particularly with an extended absence from attending Mass.

Holy Matrimony

Couples wishing to marry should contact the parish office six months before a wedding. Why so long? Because this Sacrament, not just the ceremony, requires serious preparation. And the Church needs to be involved in that preparation. The Church needs to support couples through the years of married life and offers programs to enhance married life. To learn about these programs, watch the bulletin.

Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration takes place each Wednesday at St. Bernadette with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 9 AM and Benediction and Reposition at 1 PM. All are welcome and encouraged to come.

Lessons from Lourdes

First: people. People like you wouldn't believe. So many people! Lines and crowds everywhere! In planes, trains, and automobiles. A priest at Lourdes can't help but think: all in need of healing, both body and soul. Every one of those individual people has a life and homes and friends and stories, and they are all in need of salvation. Gypsy beggars and street entertainers, waiters and Uber drivers, fellow priests and pilgrims, pilots and peasants. They're our connection to the universal Church and beyond. Never neglect their dignity. Pray for all God's people, one by one as you encounter them.

Second, a lesson from St. Bernadette. I read a book in France about the rise of the popularity of Lourdes and another of St. Bernadette's collected correspondence. The first showed me that what was described back then was still going on now. The phenomenal evening Rosary procession, streams of pilgrims to the Grotto. The second book helped me to rediscover appreciation for the genre of the personal letter. Our texting culture has decimated that art down to thank you notes and birthday cards, and that's a big loss. I'm resolving to do better in my letter writing and I'm also planning a pastoral letter to all our parishioners this summer as a way to share our common progress, goals, and hope for the future.

Finally, I didn't get homesick, but I did get parishesick. We now have two very nice rectories. I didn't think about them. I missed people. Spending quiet and relaxing time is good, but I absolutely love being a parish priest... I love being your priest. The Lord and His Mother are easily accessible the same everywhere in the world, but you all are here. Please know you were close in mind the whole time... even though I only checked emails once! While the break was good, it's great to be back.

Again, thanks to everyone who prayed for safe travels and a successful pilgrimage. During the journey we got to visit many other shrines and churches, including checking up on Notre Dame in Paris, as well as small medieval villages, all with beautiful places to pray. You were very much remembered to the Lord and His Mother!
