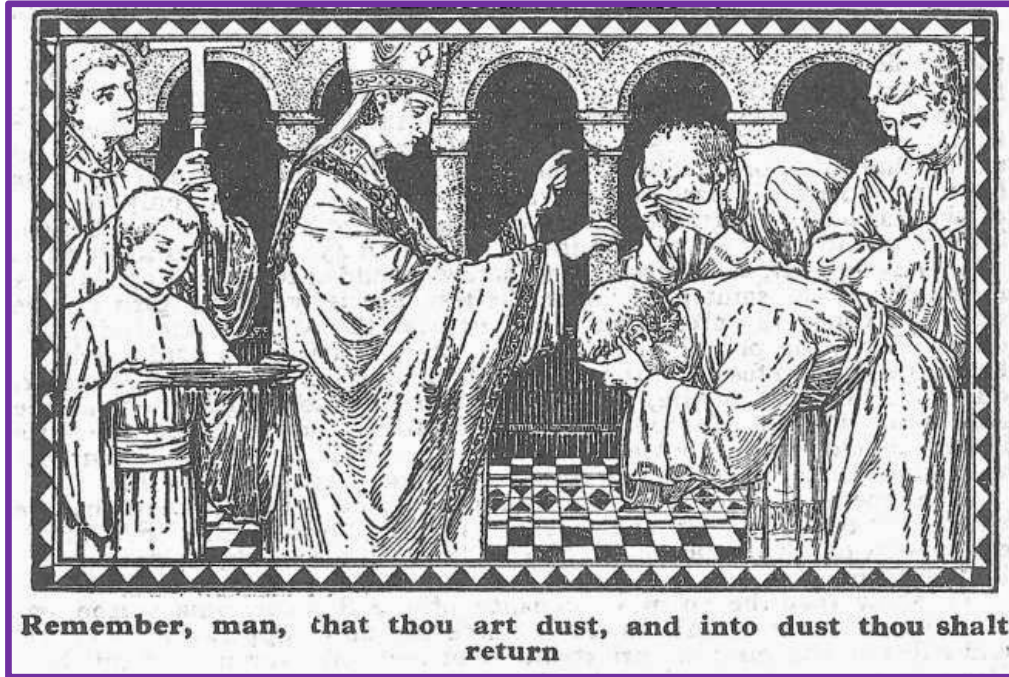

Sacramental Life

Baptism

To have a child baptized, parents must register and attend a class as a couple. Try to attend before your child is born. At least one parent and godparent must be practicing Catholics. Please call or email the church office for information or to register.

Confession

A priest is available for Penance at St. Bernadette on Saturdays at 8:30 AM and 3:00 PM, and on Thursdays at 5:30 PM. Confessions are offered Sundays at St. Mary Bremen at 8:00 AM. Every Catholic priest is available whenever needed.

Anointing and Care of the Sick

The priest gives the Anointing of the Sick to one who is dangerously ill, facing major surgery, or suffering from the ravages of old age. Call the parish office to inform us if a loved one is in need of pastoral care in sickness, particularly with an extended absence from attending Mass.

Holy Matrimony

Couples wishing to marry should contact the parish office six months before a wedding. Why so long? Because this Sacrament, not just the ceremony, requires serious preparation. And the Church needs to be involved in that preparation. The Church needs to support couples through the years of married life and offers programs to enhance married life. Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration takes place each Wednesday at St. Bernadette with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 9:00 AM and Benediction and Reposition at 2:00 PM. Exposition also takes place each Thursday at St. Bernadette from 7:00 PM until MIDNIGHT. On the first Thursday of the month we offer a Eucharistic Holy Hour at St. Mary in Bremen after the morning Mass. All are welcome to come as you are able, or stop in for prayer anytime.

Collar Corner

Lent is here! Make your preparations today. Also: everyone invite someone to come to Mass. Whether non-Catholic, fallen away, whatever... you will be surprised at the grace of this season.

Wednesday is a day of fasting, and Fridays have required abstaining from meat. See details below including Mass times and other Lenten offerings. Lent calls us to fasting, prayer, and almsgiving: that is, give something up, do something extra, help somebody else. Find a way to do them all. Write down your commitments. Need ideas? Read the daily Mass readings every morning. Don't put cream in your coffee. Go to Stations. Give up social media, or delete the phone apps. Dress up for Mass. Donate to the diaper drive. Pray a Rosary every day. Do one chapter a day of a spiritual book. Tune in only to AM820. Listen to a Catholic podcast. Stop using ketchup. Visit someone homebound. Volunteer with the St. Vincent DePaul Society. Skip desserts. Drink only water. Pray for friends, and tell them. List 40 blessings; thank God for each of them. Give away 40 things. Don't shop online. Compliment someone sincerely every single day. Write a letter to someone lonely. Get a gift for someone for no real reason. Charge your phone in the kitchen at night. Don't use the microwave. Come pray Morning Prayer or Evening Prayer. Do 40 push-ups and 40 sit-ups every day. If all else fails, offer extra prayers for your clergy! Hopefully you know that we are praying for you and are happy to help in any way that we can.

The Holy Season of Lent

Fast and Abstinence

During Lent, Catholics in the United States

- abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent. Catholics 14 and older are bound by the law of abstinence;
- fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. That means we eat only one full meal on those days; one or two smaller meals may be taken those days, but may not total one full meal. And no eating between meals. All adults are bound by the law of fast until they are 59.

Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday is February 26. Ashes will be imposed at St. Bernadette at 8:20 AM and at 6 PM Masses and at St. Mary at NOON Mass. Solemn exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Bernadette will occur after morning Mass as usual.

Way of the Cross

On all the Fridays of Lent at 7:00 PM, St. Mary and St. Bernadette parishes will both pray the Way of the Cross, followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

Evening Prayer

On all of the Sundays of Lent, Evening Prayer will be prayed in the church at St. Bernadette at 5:00 PM. Morning Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours is prayed at 8:00 AM every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday morning at St. Bernadette and Thursdays at St. Mary. These are open to everyone.

Thursday Virtues Conferences

As Adoration begins Thursdays at 6:30 PM, we will offer reflections on the virtues: faith, hope, charity, prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance.

New Podcast

A Lenten podcast called Credatis will be available on all the major platforms. It will offer a series of short seasonal reflections.

Fish Fry

Lancaster Knights of Columbus will fry fish on the Fridays of Lent. Bremen St. Mary Parish will fry fish on one Friday in Lent, accepting a donation for the food pantry. After the fish, come to either church for the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 PM.

In addition to the regularly scheduled weekly Confession opportunities, Penance Services will be available throughout the deanery. A complete list will be published soon.
