

St. Mary School Tuition Schedule 2020-2021 School Year

Parishioner Rate K– 6 Tuition - \$2,940

**** *Includes all fees except \$100 registration per family. (\$150 if paid after April 24, 2020)*
\$294 monthly payments (10 month plan)

Non-Parishioner Rate K – 6 Tuition - \$3,740

**** *Includes all fees except \$100 registration per family. (\$150 if paid after April 24, 2020)*
\$374 monthly payments (10 month plan)

What is a Parishioner?

Families are eligible to receive a **Parishioner Rate** if they:

- Are Catholics attending St. Mary Church, Vermilion
- Are registered parishioners at St. Mary Church, Vermilion
- Are registered parishioners of another local Catholic Church without a school
- Attend Mass regularly
- Contribute to the financial support of the Parish
- Contribute service to the parish or school

***ACTUAL COSTS to educate a child at St. Mary School.....

The actual cost to educate a student at St. Mary School is **NOT** the tuition amount. It is approximately \$7,000 and rising per student. We are very grateful that **the balance of the educational costs are subsidized by the people of St. Mary Parish.**

ST. MARY SCHOOL TUITION ASSISTANCE OPTIONS:

1. **St. Mary School/ Parish Tuition Assistance** - *Eligibility: All families may apply, priority given to those in most financial need, Application needed*
2. **Ed Choice Expansion Scholarship** - *Eligibility: State Scholarship awarded to families who meet the Federal requirements for low income.*
3. **Ed Choice Scholarship** - *Eligibility: State Scholarship to students who live in academically poor performing public school districts that qualify.*
4. **Jon Peterson Scholarship** - *Eligibility: State Scholarship awarded to students who possess an IEP*
5. **Northwest Ohio Scholarship** – *Eligibility: Lower income and a resident of Erie County. Maximum amount given is \$1,500. Recipients are selected randomly by lottery system. **Deadline to apply for this scholarship is Friday, April 24, 2020.***
