In December, St. Francis 7th-8th graders donated gifts to those in need. They donated \$20 cash to purchase a "flock of chicks" through Heifer International. This gift provides a family with over 200 eggs or chicks in a year. This provides food for the family and eggs/chickens can be sold at market to raise funds for medicine or clothing. Chickens require very little space, allowing families with small plots of land to maximize what they plant. Chickens help farm production by eating insects, removing weeds and even fertilizing crops. The \$35 cash donation was designated for clothes and it will go to a needy family in Northeast Iowa.
