- ◆ In Cedar Rapids and Marion, "Pietra Fitness" classes are being offered at two parishes. The exercise routines are similar to Yoga, but integrate Catholic prayer and spirituality instead of Hindu. An article will profile the local leaders of these classes, part of a wider movement, and the concepts behind them.
- ◆ A time capsule from 1907 was recently found in the corner stone of Vistation Hall during its demolition. The building originally housed a Catholic girls school and was later a dormitory for Loras College. It was heavily damaged by a fire in 2016. The details of the surprise discovery will be revealed in The Witness.
