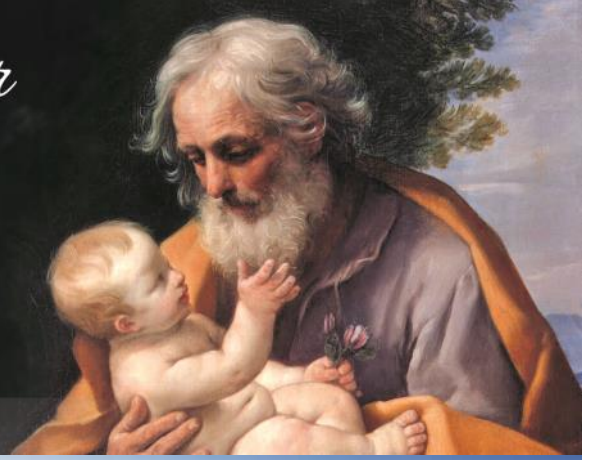

The St. Lucas Historical Society is sponsoring a workshop at the German American Museum on Wednesday, June 20th - 9:00 am – 5:00 pm - "The Native American Presence: Past, Present and Future". Renowned presenters are from the Ho Chunk Nation, the University of Iowa, Upper Iowa University, U.S. Corps of Engineers, University of Illinois and other knowledgeable local speakers. Workshop includes a field trip to the local historic Indian Sub Agency, cultural displays of the Ho Chunk Nation, artifacts of local people and also native Ojibwe crafts on display and some for sale from the St. Francis Solanus Indian Mission from Lac Courte Oreilles Indian Reservation, Reserve, Wisconsin.
