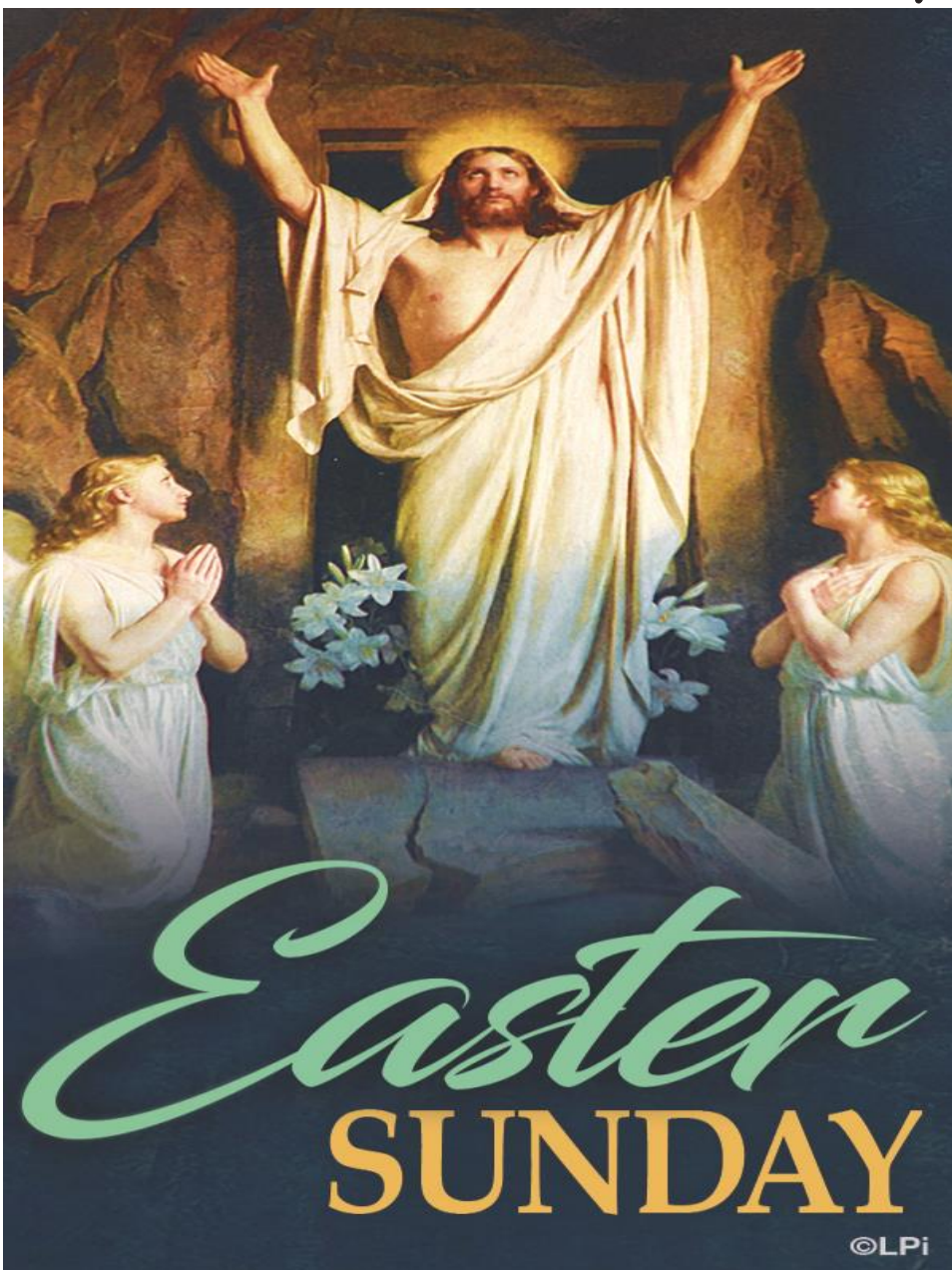

EASTER BLESSINGS - 2019



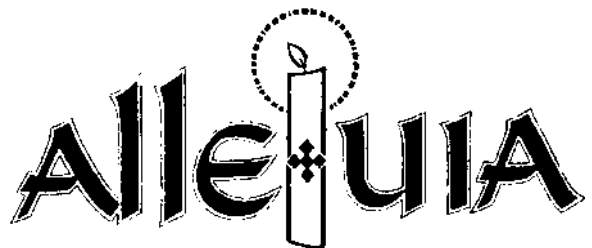
