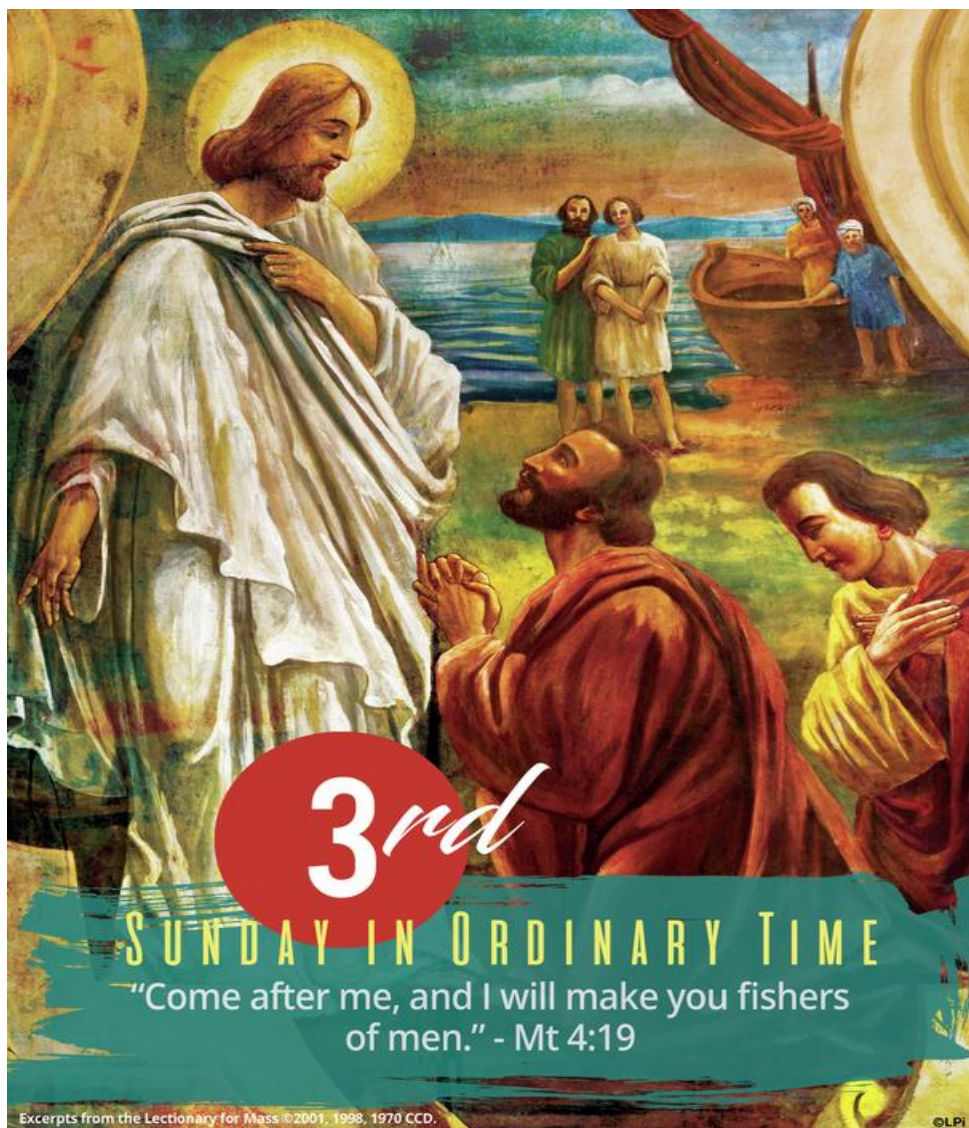

**Ordinary Time - Liturgical Color: Green**

The theological virtue of hope is symbolized by the color green, just as the burning fire of love is symbolized by red. Green is the color of growing things, and hope, like them, is always new and always fresh. Liturgically, green is the color of Ordinary Time, the season in which we are being neither especially penitent (in purple) nor overwhelmingly joyful (in white).

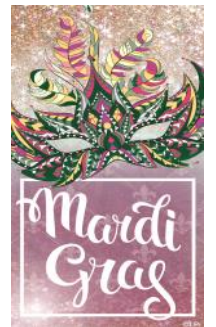
