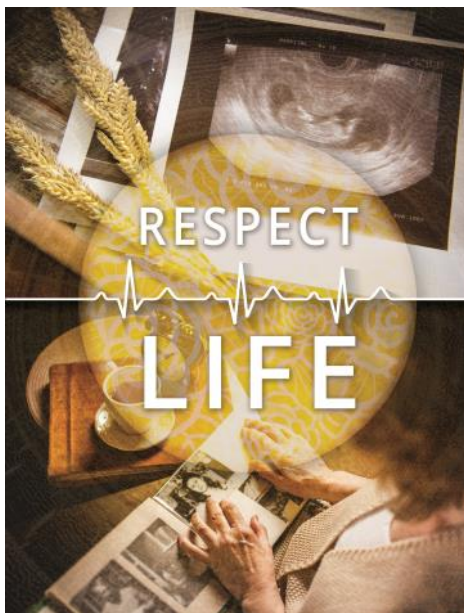

Several reports have been received that parishioners are receiving fraudulent text messages and emails from someone posing as (Pastor's Name).

The messages are similar to the following:

”(Recipient's Name) I need a favor from you, text me as soon as you get this message. God Bless you. (Pastor's Name). If you reply the scammer will ask you to purchase gift cards and share with them the codes on the back. Please know Fr. Komboh is not going to make such requests. If you are in doubt about a message from Fr. Komboh please contact the parish offices.
