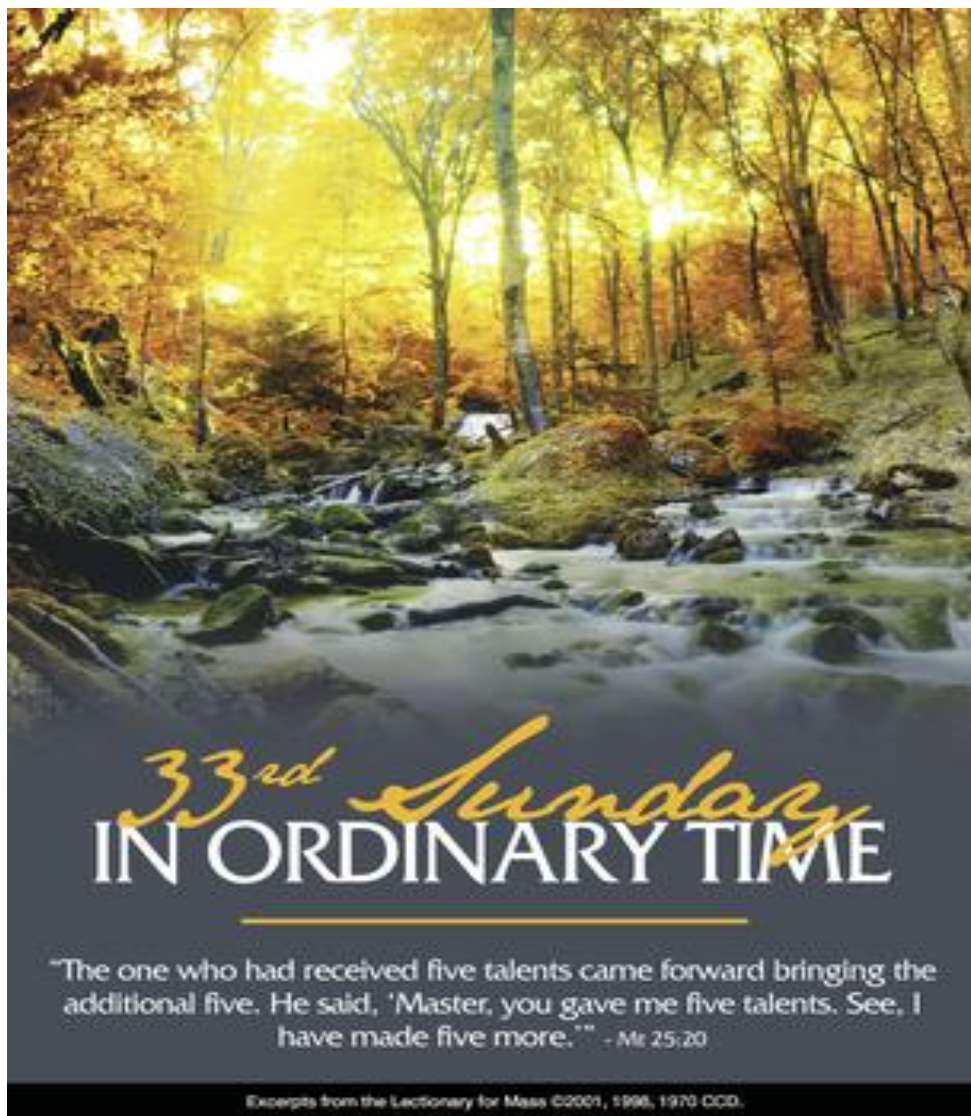

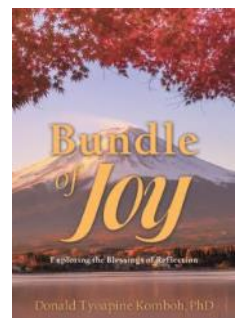
Archbishop Jackels described wearing a mask as
