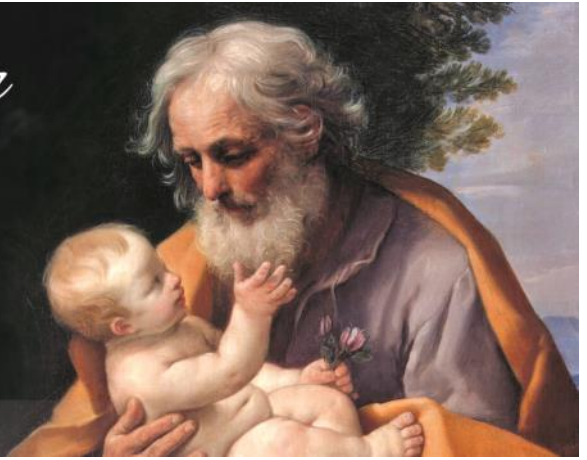

The doctor said, "I have devoted my life to the sick and needy and have had a part in caring for and healing thousands of people."

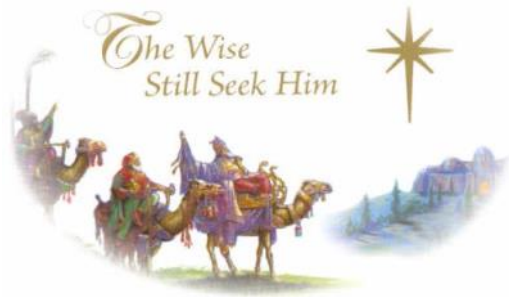
St. Peter replied, "That's great. Go ahead into heaven."
