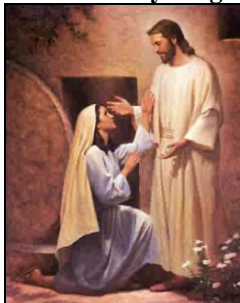

Baptism
