Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time September 10, 2017



As you are aware, every year I nominate an extraordinary parishioner who serves with devotion in our parish for the Vivere Christus Award. This year I have nominated Deacon Vin and Peggy Leo. This Sunday the 10th I join them at the cathedral for a prayer service during which time Bishop Serratelli will give awards to parishioners throughout the diocese who have served in this capacity.

Vinny and Peggy Leo built their house and moved to East Hanover in April of 1970 and became parishioners of St. Rose of Lima. They have two adult children, Peggy Jean and Vincent Jr. and five grandchildren, Carson Lee, Cade, Tyler, Chase and Ava. Deacon Vin was the Grand Knight of the East Hanover Council of the Knights of Columbus from 1973-1974. He served on the East Hanover Township committee from 1975-1983 and was elected mayor in 1982. Vinny was ordained a Permanent Deacon by Bishop Rodimer on May 5, 2001. The family moved to Boonton Township in 1985. After his ordination in 2001 he served at Our Lady of the Magnificat until I was appointed here in 2003. Upon my request, Bishop Rodimer appointed him to St. Rose shortly after I was installed as pastor.

Peggy taught at St. Rose of Lima Academy from 1978-1983. She assisted in the Religious Ed program in the mid 70's and served as a member of Parish Council. Since returning to St. Rose Peggy has been on team leadership in the Confirmation Program. She coordinates, trains, and schedules the Readers for Sundays and holy days.

Deacon Vin, with the assistance of his adoring wife, and with the help of other parishioners, began a social concerns group and from that sprang the idea of a food pantry which serves so many in need today. Both Deacon Vin and Peggy serve the parish in so many ways with great love and devotion. In the name of our parish I thank them for their years of devoted service and look forward to many more years of working together in the vineyard of the Lord.

We welcome back the Dakrat family who every year offer for sale beautiful Olivewood carvings made by hand in the Bethlehem area. Stop by and enjoy the beautiful selection they offer.
