I'm deeply touched by the amount of people who responded positively to the Several Sources Lenten Appeal. The talks given by Kathy and Conrad were heart wrenching and yet beautiful. Kathy has been an angel to so many moms and babies for close to forty years.

I can't even imagine the many lives she and her organization have saved and the great dignity she and they give to the moms and babies. Conrad, now in his mid 20's, was one of those babies. Now he's studying in college and prepared to make a difference in the lives of many. In a world where so many people desperately want a child and so many couples have difficulty conceiving, it's sad to see that many moms see abortion as their only way out. Whether the mom keeps the child or makes a decision to have her child adopted into a beautiful family, this child of God can use his or her gifts in the world in which God planted them to live in.

Catholics need to be politically incorrect and never feel embarrassed to discuss Catholic morality. What's more sacred than human life? How vulnerable is life in the womb, especially when that life is unwanted by the parent/parents. As Catholics we support the gift of life. Be it a young or older mom without any support or be it a married couple who feel they can't provide for another child, what can we do to help? We can all have the address and phone number to Several Sources available so that we can make a suggestion towards life. We can remind the mom that her decision will not only affect the life of her unborn child but affect her life forever. Those in the abortion clinic never explain to a mom about the guilt she feels every year for the rest of her life as she remembers the due date of her baby. That beautiful life that she gave up on. Over the years I've consulted many women who had abortions and through the grace of the sacrament of confession, forgiven them for their sin and afterwards encouraged them to forgive themselves and to experience the merciful love of the crucified and resurrected Christ. We know my friends that life is a special gift. Let each of us strive to promote that gift and never be afraid to voice our concerns for the precious life in the womb.

In conclusion, Kathy told me the other day they just received a new resident to the facility. A young woman, strong and healthy in the late stage of pregnancy who is expecting twins. Who knows who these beautiful twins will grow up to be? We know they will certainly be a gift from God.

Congratulations to Karen Martucci, a former Presbyterian, who I brought into the Holy Roman Catholic Church last Friday through the Profession of Faith, Holy Communion and Confirmation. Congratulations Karen Rose – welcome to our family!

I recently went to see the movie Paul, the Apostle. The movie tells the story of St. Paul and it is a must see. It certainly helps us to see and truly understand the strength of faith St. Paul, St. Luke, his beloved physician, and the many Christians had in the risen Lord. Despite their persecution, they remained steadfast to the faith. Do give yourself a treat and make time to see this incredible movie. I would like to have a presentation on the Letters of St. Paul and in particular on the life of St. Paul and the early Christian community. If you don't have time to see the movie, read the Letters of St. Paul and come along for a lively discussion that will enhance our faith.
