**Confirmation Program 2021-2022**  
**Program Outline**

Welcome to the St. Rose of Lima Confirmation Program! This is a two year preparation program to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. This program is your final step to becoming an adult in the Catholic church, understanding and practicing our faith!

**Mass Participation**

Mass participation and attendance is an instrumental part of our program and your commitment to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation! As we attend mass each week, it is important to listen, think, and reflect! This year, we will all participate in monthly mass reflections. You may bring a small notebook or journal to mass with you each week to jot down and record your thoughts during mass. All monthly reflections will be due via email on the last day of the month!

- Weekly mass attendance (any mass of your choice when we don't have class!)
- Jot down your thoughts and ideas to reflect on each week

**Class Attendance**

All class nights are mandatory for students to attend. Of course, we know that life happens! Please note that the last class night for all grades (March 6th & 27th) will be a make-up class night for anyone who has missed. Please plan to attend this class night if you miss any other nights. Attendance will be taken at the front desk upon student's arrival each night.

- 6 class nights per grade
- March class nights will be held as make-ups
- Students must attend the 7:00pm Mass after each class night

**Community Service**

In order to grow in our own faith, it is important that we help those around us! Students are asked to complete 20 hours of community service in our town, schools, church, etc. each year of the two year program (40 hours total by the time they receive Confirmation).

- All hours should be recorded by the Confirmandi on the community service documentation form (Students will receive the form at orientation)
- Documentation forms will be submitted digitally at the end of each year of the program
- Students are encouraged to participate in at least 3 different service opportunities

**Retreats**

Students will attend one retreat each year of the program in order to build their own spiritual life and make connections with other Confirmandi! These retreats are led by our St. Rose Antioch Team! (Please see the calendar for dates)
