- the five [JOYFUL MYSTERIES](#),
- the five [LUMINOUS MYSTERIES](#),
- the five [SORROWFUL MYSTERIES](#),
- and the five [GLORIOUS MYSTERIES](#).
- . As suggested by the Pope St. John Paul the Great,
- the [Joyful](#) mysteries are said on Monday and Saturday,
- the [Luminous](#) on Thursday,
- the [Sorrowful](#) on Tuesday and Friday,
- and the [Glorious](#) on Wednesday and Sunday (with this exception: Sundays of Christmas season - The Joyful; Sundays of Lent - Sorrowful).
