## The St. Joseph Marello Marian Guild Presents Check to Mustard Seed School



Throughout the Lenten season, at various meetings and events, the Marian Guild collects almsgiving donations from our members. 100% of the contributions are earmarked for a charitable organization. This year, the Executive Board chose Mustard Seed, a school for homeless children, as the recipient. The school is located in Sacramento, adjacent to Loaves and Fishes. On Wednesday, June 12, Guild members visited and toured Mustard Seed School and presented the Director and staff with a check for \$2,104.00. The donation will be applied to Mustard Seed

School's capital campaign (a Mercy Foundation Initiative) to fund the construction of a new playground with equipment, a garden, a grassy play area, and an outdoor classroom. In addition to the check, Guild members brought several boxes of children's books to give to the staff and children. It was a delightful day of giving! Thank you to all our members and parishioners who donated during the Guild's Lenten Almsgiving Project.

## Lighthouse CD of the Week: Meet Your Mother: An Introduction to Mary

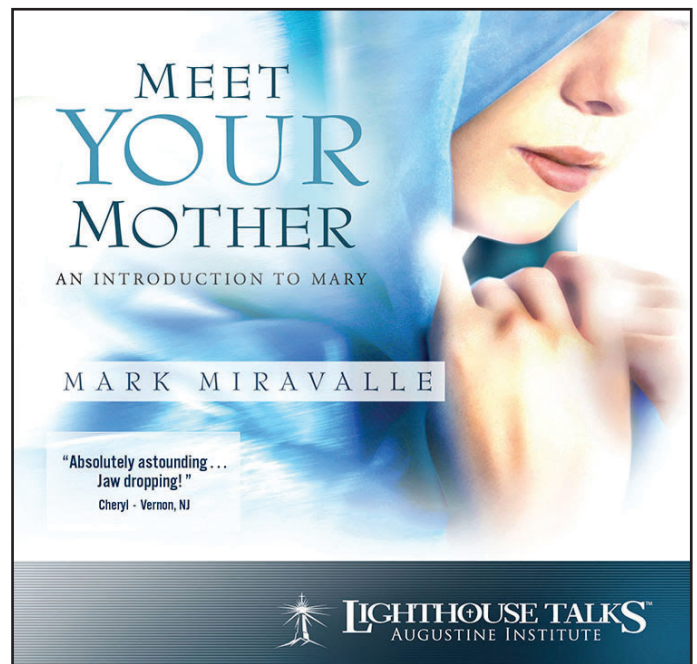

## You Haven't Been Baptized, Received First Eucharist or Been Confirmed?

### RCIA Ministry Classes Begin on Monday, September 9, 2019

If you have not yet heard of "RCIA," it stands for Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

All **Baptized Catholic adults** who have not yet received the Sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation, or **non-Catholic adults** who wish to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Eucharist, and Confirmation), are invited to participate in our upcoming RCIA Ministry sessions.

Through the RCIA Ministry, **non-Catholic adults** will learn about our Catholic faith, and prepare to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the **Easter Vigil on Saturday, April 11, 2020**. **Baptized Catholic adults** will receive instruction that will prepare them for receiving the Sacrament of First Eucharist and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation.

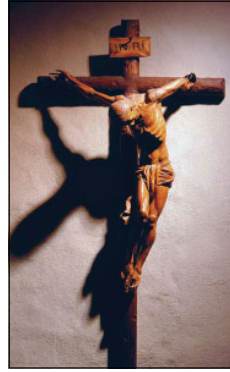
