For my Eagle Project, I will be leading a collection of baby items for a South African orphanage called Dove's Nest Place of Safety, a home in Pretoria, South Africa, for abandoned newborns babies.

The South African government provides the equivalent of only \$1 per day, per child to fund their care, so as a result, most of the feeding and caring costs, are supported through private donations.

I am collecting **new or gently used basic baby clothing**, aged newborn through 24 months, appropriate for any season. In addition to baby clothing, I am also collecting **bottles, pacifiers, and diaper cream**.

Donations can be dropped off on the back porch of the parish center.

Any monetary donations received will be used to purchase a familiar brand of formula used by the orphanage, while in South Africa.
