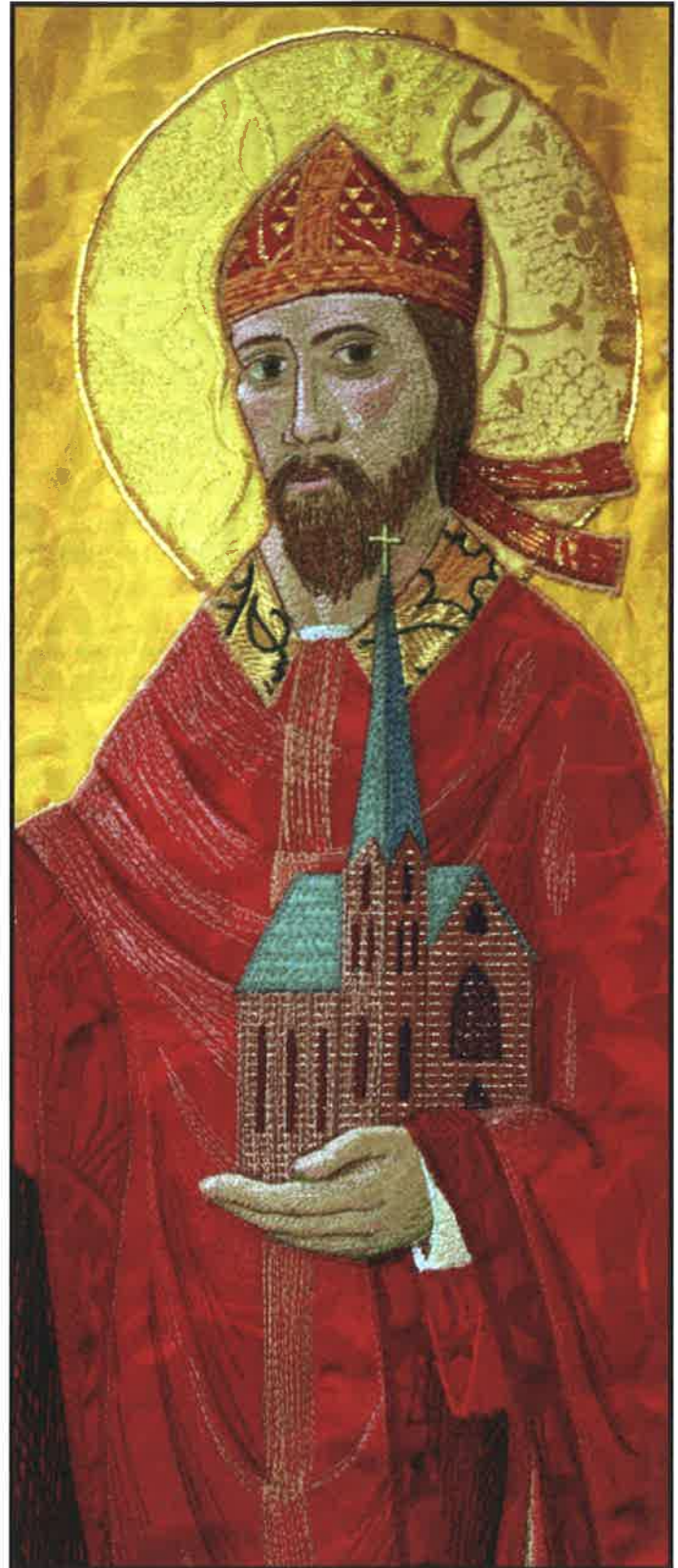

What is your Spiritual Charism?

To follow up with the Spiritual Gifts Workshop in October 2015, we will look at each of the Charisms presented. Message from Brett Garland...

Dear St. Colman Parish Family,

It was a great joy for me to celebrate my admission to candidacy with so many of you on the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. In our diocese, admission to candidacy is the last step that seminarians take before being ordained transitional deacons, and eventually priests. These rites normally take place in Columbus, either at the Josephinum or at the Cathedral, and are not usually accessible to members of our parish community. I asked permission of Bishop Campbell to have the rite of candidacy at St. Colman's as a way of including all of you more directly in my journey to the Holy Priesthood.

Of course, St. Colman's has played a role in this journey since I was baptized here in December of 1990. Over the past 25 years I have been formed by so many of you through instruction in CCD classes, through words of encouragement (before and after I became a seminarian), through your living example of faith and devotion, and through your many prayers. It has been such a privilege to be a "son" of this parish. I wonder how many other young men God may be calling to consider a vocation to the priesthood.

I have now completed two and a half years of seminary formation, and I have two and a half years to go before I am ordained a priest. I pray in thanksgiving for your company on this journey, and look forward to the day when, please God, I will be able to celebrate my first Mass of Thanksgiving at St. Colman's with all of you.

Please continue to pray for me and my seminarian brothers, and be assured of my prayers for all of you. *Oremus pro invicem* (Let us pray for one another).
