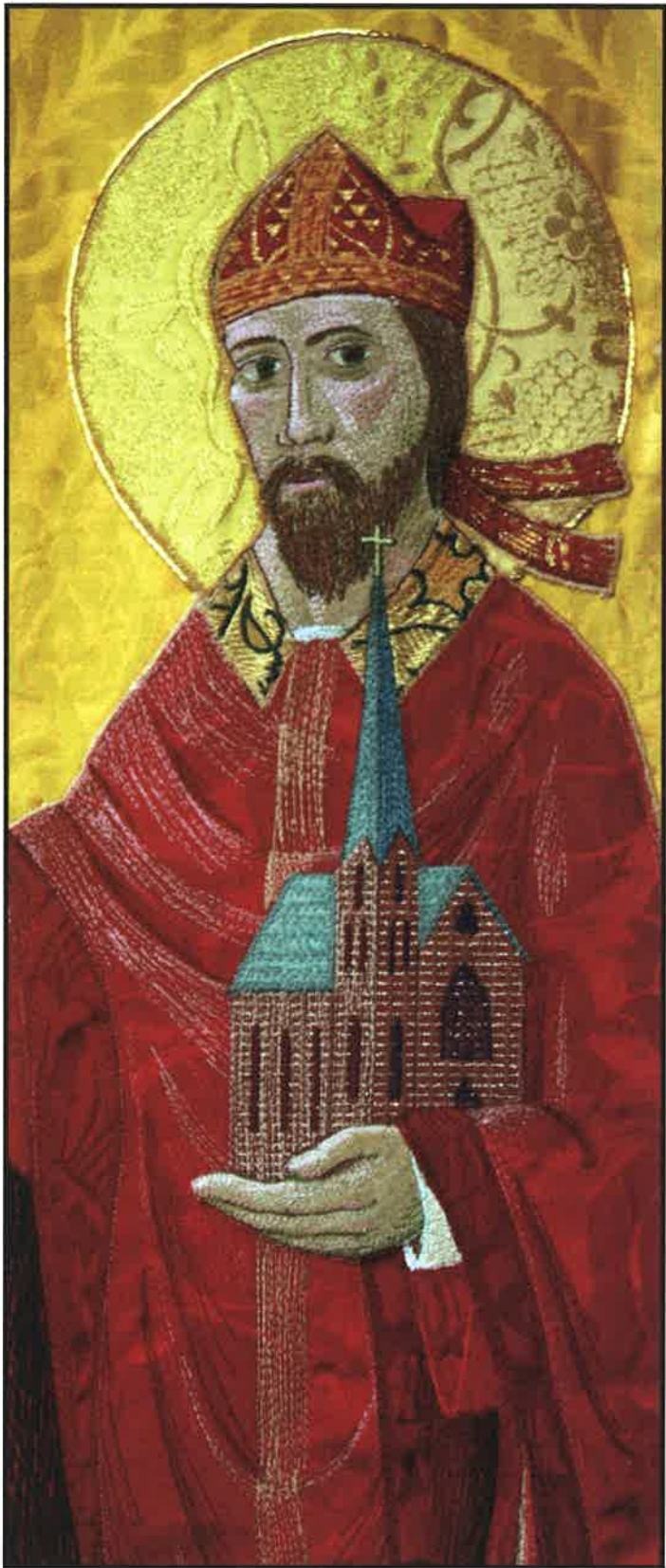

Jim Ward

James Francis "Jim" Ward, 77, of Washington Court House, Ohio died too soon on Monday, November 7, 2016, at 8:59 p.m. at Riverside Methodist Hospital in Columbus where he had been a patient since October 28.



Jim was a loving and caring husband to Nancy, whom he married August 17, 1963. He was deeply dedicated to his family, faith and community and always a hard worker, great friend, and proud mentor. He lived life to the fullest.

Jim was born January 28, 1939, in Plattsburgh, NY to William George and Helen Nappa Ward. He was a 1957 graduate of Staples High School in Westport, CT and received a degree in industrial management in 1965 from Wilmington College.

He was a successful business man, opening French Hardware in 1971. He formerly worked for the Cincinnati Milacron Company in Cincinnati and Wilmington. He had also worked for ITT Semiconductors in West Palm Beach, FL and Fairchild Camera and Instrument Corporation in Mountain View, CA.

He was a proud and active member of the St. Colman of Cloyne Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus. He also served in the United States Army.

He was deeply passionate about the community and was driven by his desire for service over self. Some of his achievements were serving on the Fayette County Memorial Hospital Board; president of the Southern State Community College Board of Trustees; chair of the Fayette County Republican Committee; member and past president of the Washington Rotary Club; chairman of the South Central Ohio AAA board; former member and chairman of Washington City Council; past president of the Fayette County Chamber of Commerce; former member of the Fayette County Fair Board and the Metropolitan Housing Authority board.

Jim was preceded in death by an infant son, James Francis Ward, Jr. in 1968; also by a brother, John P. Ward and a brother-in-law, John C. (Jack) French.

Jim has always and will continue to shape our understanding of family and its importance.

Surviving, in addition to his wife, the former Nancy Lou French, are three sons and daughters-in-law, Douglas J. and Dana Ward of Glenview, IL, Matthew C. and Dawn Ward of Canton, MI; David M. and Kelly Ward of Grandview Heights, Ohio. He was a loving "Pops" to seven grandchildren, Ella, Chase, Amelia, Katherine, Madeline, Maggie and Audrey Ward. He is also survived by a sister and brother-in-law, Joan and Phil Lauterbach of Redding, CT; cousins, Charles and Helen Claibourne of Lewis Center, Ohio and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral Mass was held Saturday, November 12, 2016 at 10 a.m. at the St. Colman of Cloyne Catholic Church with the Rev. Father Michael Hartge officiating. Burial was in the Sugar Grove Cemetery in Wilmington, Ohio.
