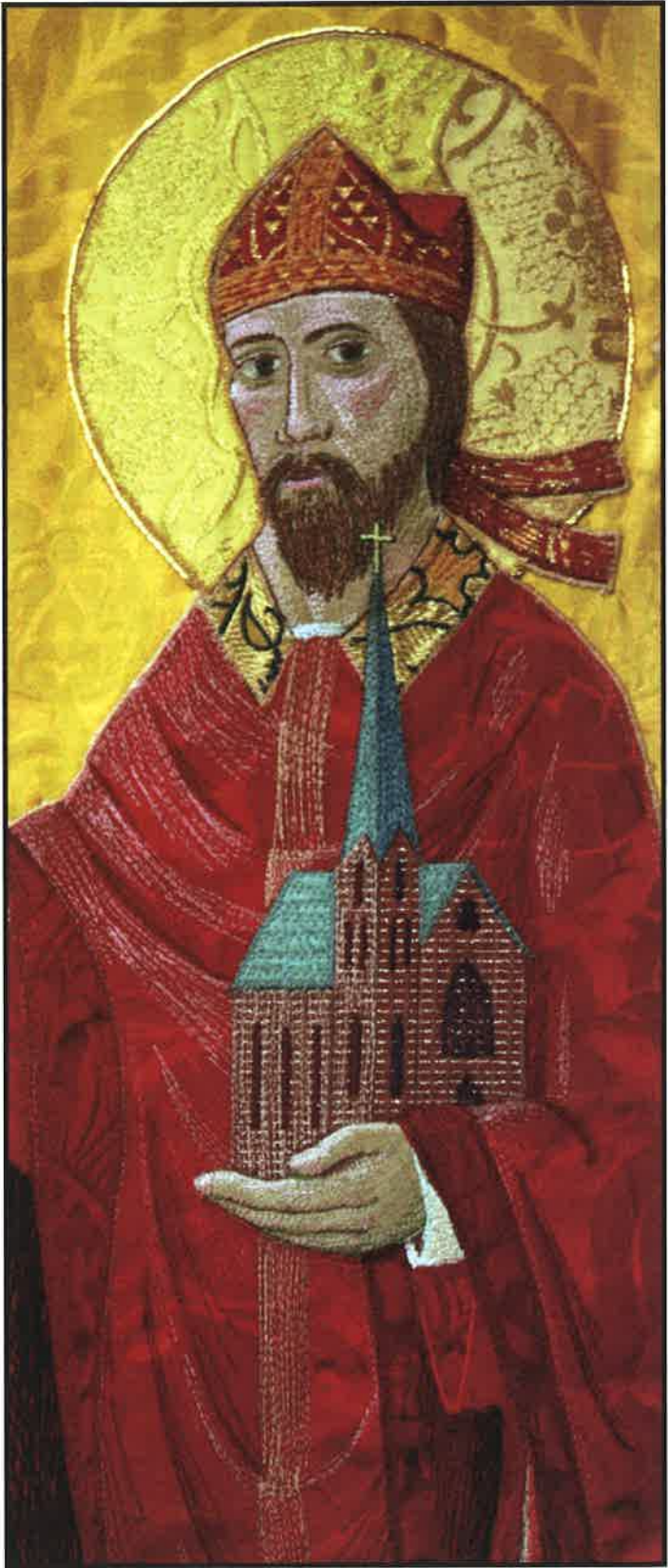

LESSONS AND CAROLS for ADVENT 2016

The choir of St. Colman Catholic Church will present it's 12th Annual service of scripture readings and music which focus on the prophecies concerning the coming of Messiah, his birth and his coming again.

Readings are interspersed with carols and hymns by the choir and congregation which reflect upon the meaning of each lesson. Guest readers for 2016 are seminarians from the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus.
