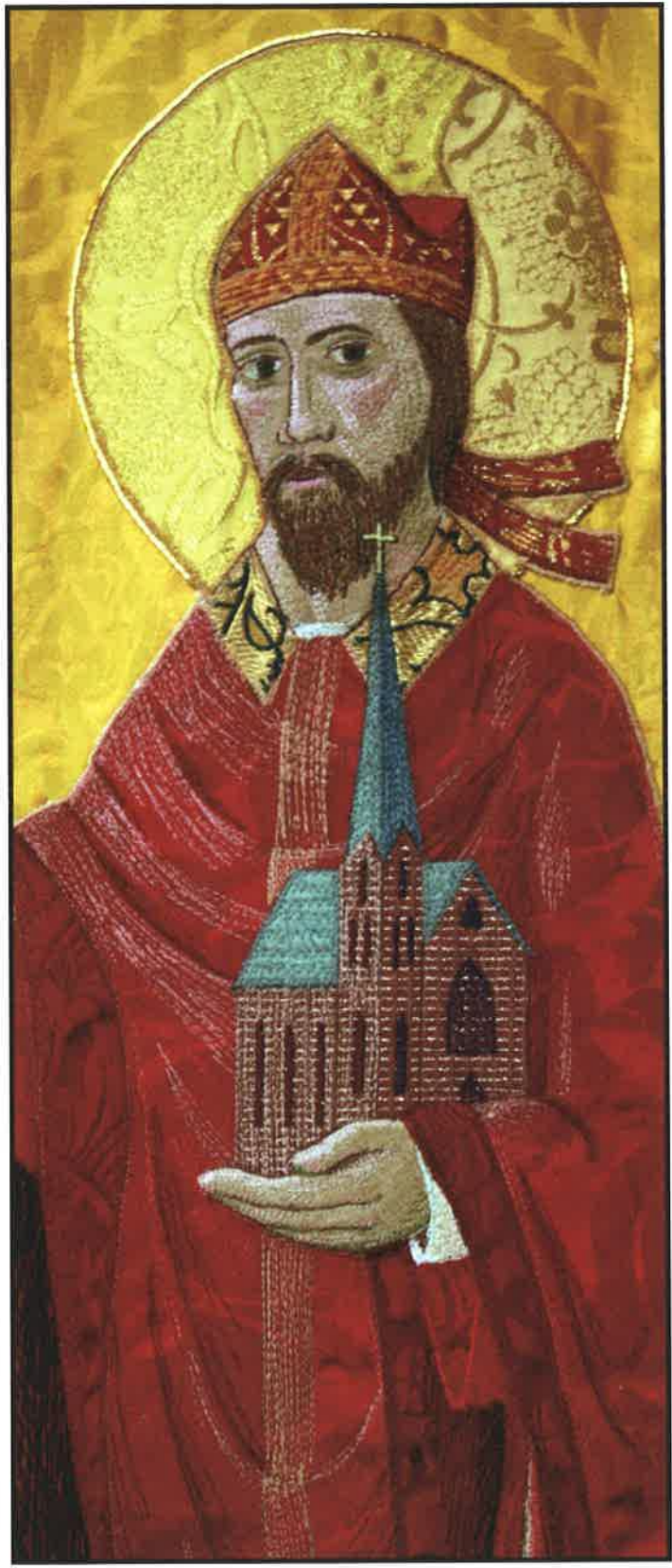

# Phyllis Ann Casey



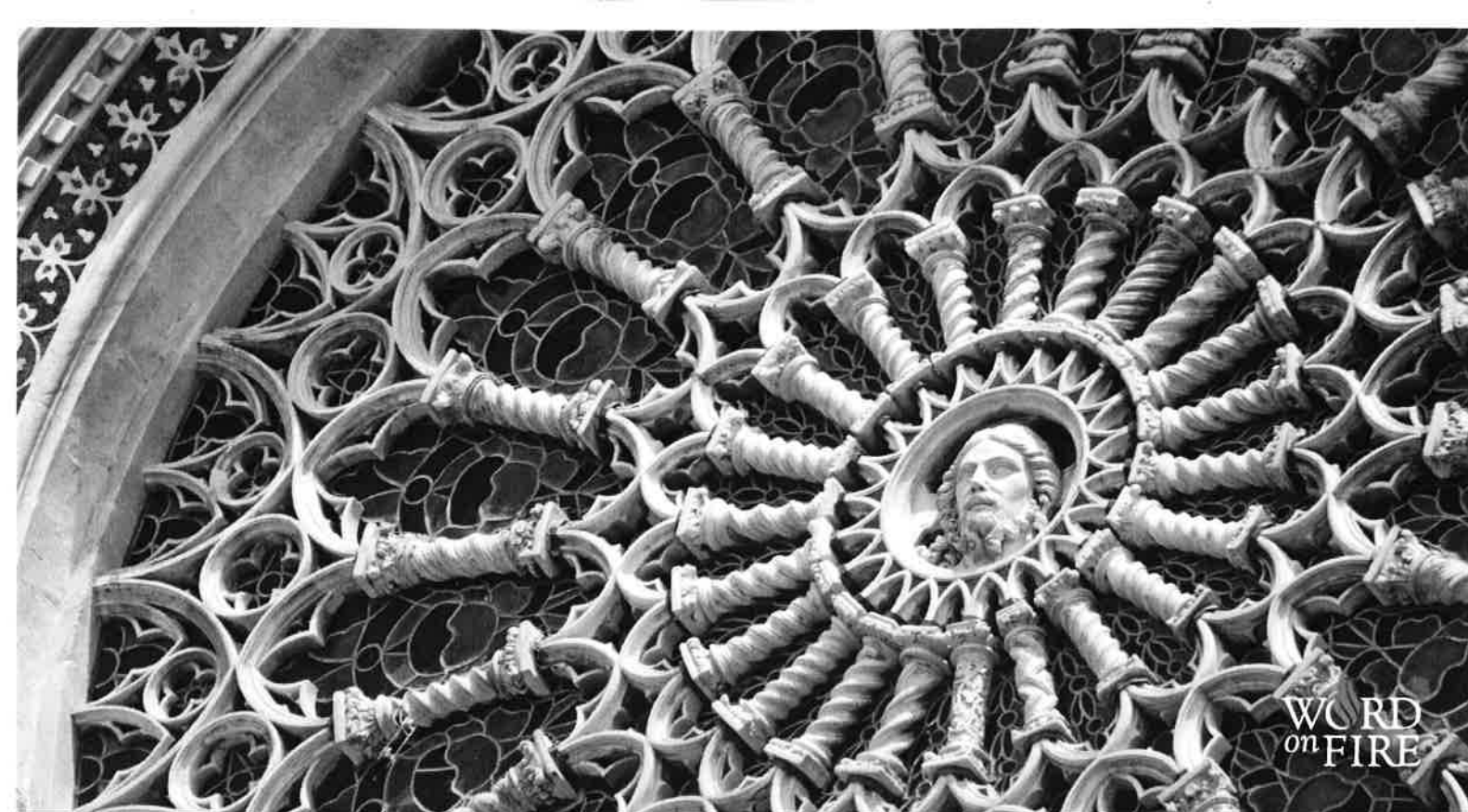

*Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. And let the perpetual light shine upon them.*

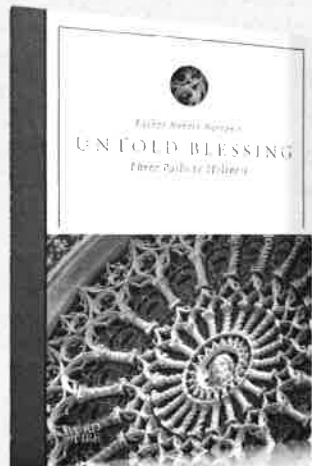
