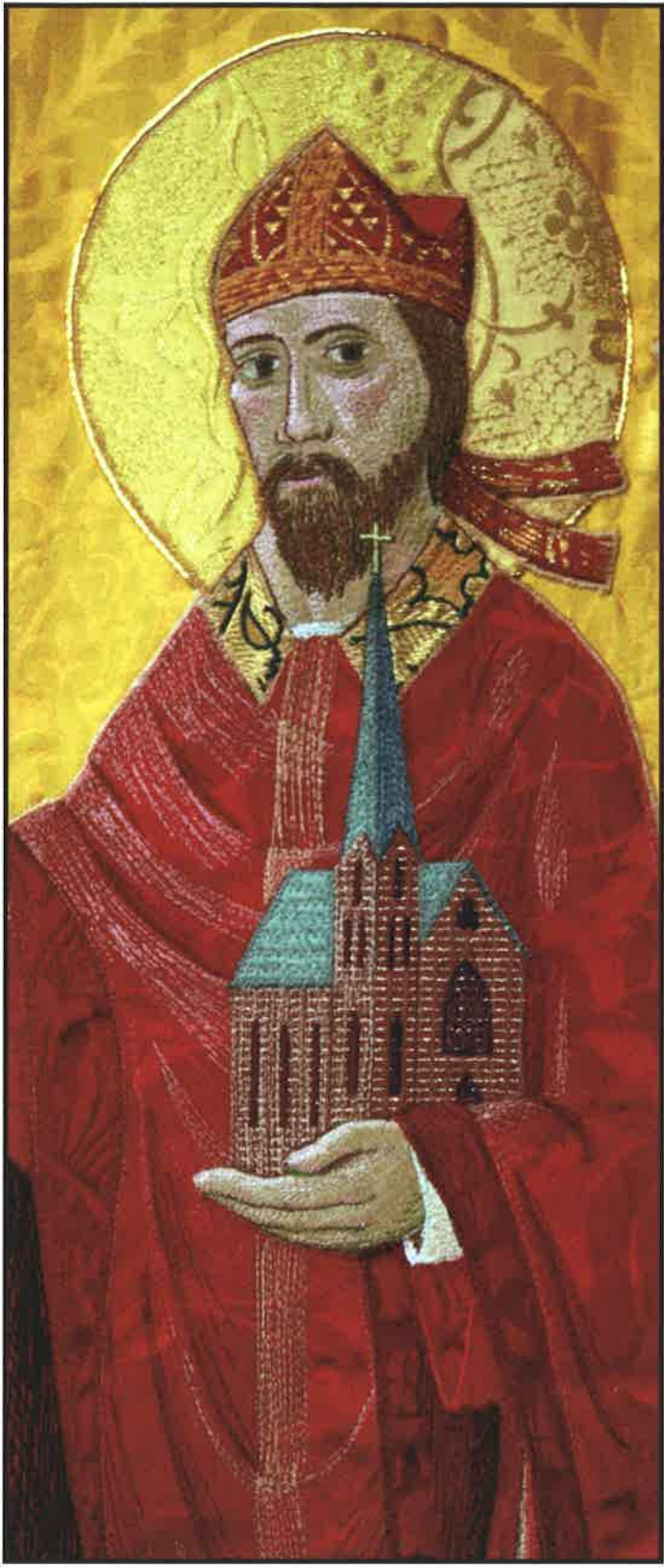

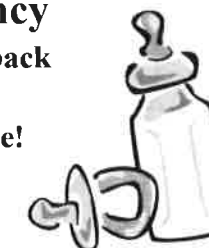

## Five First Saturdays Devotion

Devotions in our lives should lead us to greater *devotion* in Our Lord. One can have a devotion to a particular saint asking that saint for special prayer and intercession. We do this when we ask St. Anthony to help us find our lost car keys! We can have a devotion

to the image of the Divine Mercy or the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. When we participate in these devotional practices, we do not do so with superstition that we will be miraculously granted some request. They assist us in deepening our devotion to our Loving God, and desiring to model our lives more closely to Jesus.

The 5 First Saturdays devotion that Our Lady requested at Fatima in 1917 was not so that we do certain things on 5 consecutive first Saturdays in a superstitious way. Instead, Fr. Andrew Apostoli, CFR calls it a sort of religious formation program. In his book, *Fatima for Today*, he compares the 5 First Saturdays devotion to the different stages of formation one undertakes in religious life, but this type of formation is meant for all of us. This so called devotional formation program of 5 First Saturdays consists of four actions that Our Lady of Fatima asked for:

1) **Go to Confession** - This helps prevent us from growing cold towards our Lord in our hearts, and reminds us that sin really does offend God. Frequent, monthly confession increases our desire and ability with God's grace to avoid sin and turn toward God. (This aspect can be fulfilled within 8 days of the first Saturday, since not all can confess on Saturday. See the bulletin for times. Confessions will be offered for a period of time following the First Saturday Mass.)

2) **Receive Holy Communion** - This was to combat Jansenism which kept people from receiving Holy Communion due to the thought that we're so corrupted that we're not worthy to receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

3) **Recite 5 decades of the Rosary** - In the home it is so often that the mother teaches the children how to pray. So, with the Rosary, Our Blessed Mother teaches us how to pray. This uses the prayer of the lips, vocal prayer. 5 decades is once around the rosary.

4) **Meditate for 15 minutes on various mysteries of the Rosary**. This is in addition to the recitation of the rosary. It is more prayer of the heart and mind in meditation. Here we attempt to enter into the heart-to-heart prayer, which truly deepens our personal relationship with Jesus and Mary. How do the mysteries speak to what is going on in your life? There is no right or wrong way to do it, but the important thing is that we do take these 15 minutes to meditate and reflect on the mysteries of the rosary.

## Father's Day Spiritual Bouquets

Spiritual Bouquets are prayers, or in this case, Intentions that are offered by someone in honor of or memory of another. These are a wonderful way to commemorate special occasions or dates in the life of the family or the church. Everyone needs prayer and this is an opportunity to come together as a community in honor of someone who has been an important part of our lives: our Fathers, Grandfathers, Godfathers, Uncles or someone who has had a fatherly influence in our lives.

Honor the men in your life with a spiritual bouquet. The names will be listed in the bulletin and included in the General Intercessions Father's Day Weekend, June 17 and 18.

The Bouquet consists of a card inside a donation envelope. A donation of \$10 is requested for each Intention. You keep the inside card and give it to the person in each Bouquet (one name per envelope). Give the inside card in its envelope to the person you are honoring. Complete the outside envelope with your Intention information, put the \$10 donation inside the envelope, and put it in the collection basket or return it to the Parish Office no later than **Monday, June 12**.
