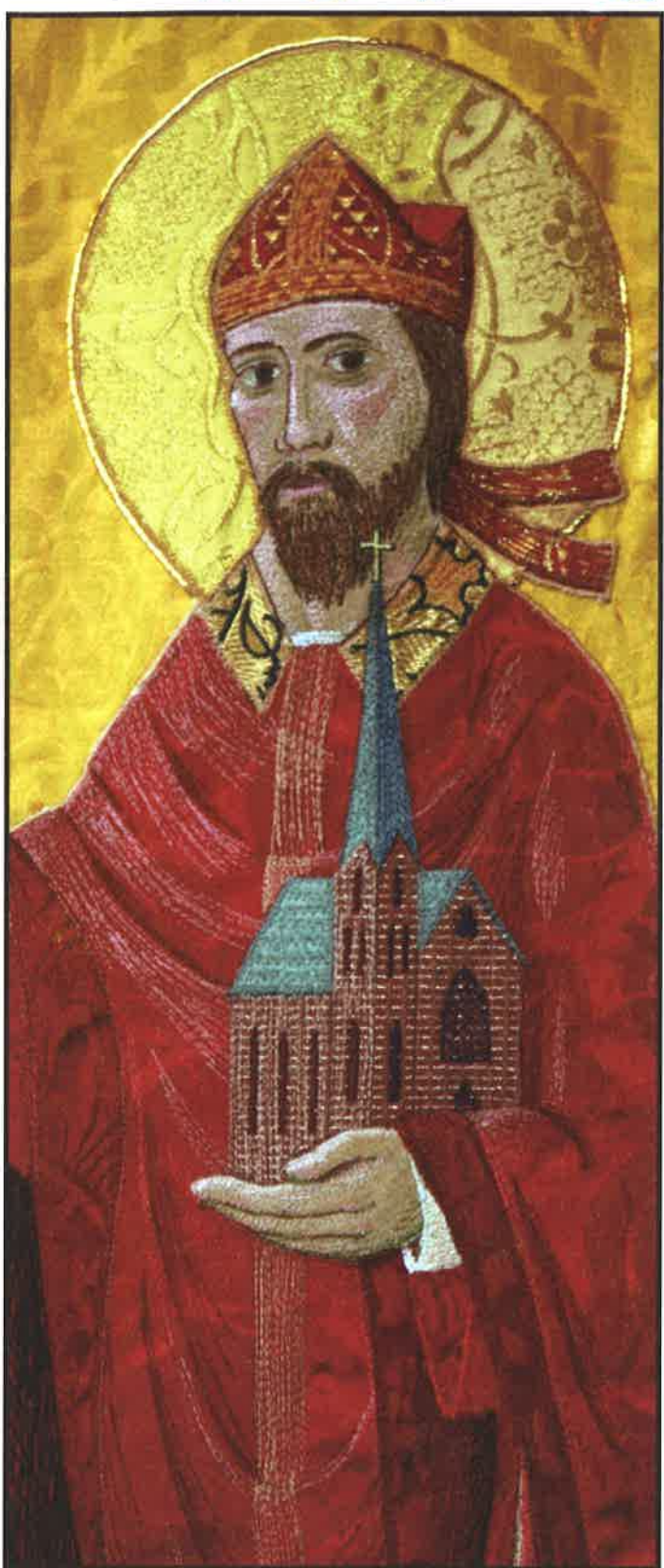

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." I find these words from Our Lord to be some of the most comforting in all of Scripture. I could read them and repeat them to myself over and over again each day, and still find deep peace each time. I don't go back to these words nearly enough. I get caught up in the tasks I must accomplish, or preoccupied with worldly concerns. I think of the many troubles and illnesses that weigh down on the lives of so many in our parish, and the people who bear them so patiently. At times I can forget about the rest that Jesus offers to me.

It's not a rest from work he offers. He wants us to work, to be productive and to glorify him with our lives. But he does not want us to be so burdened that we forget that he is with us in all these things inviting us to find refuge in adoring Him first. It is the burdens of things that are completely out of our control that He desires us to hand over to Him. As we strive to live in his love and obeying his commandments, he in turn offers us rest and refuge from the things that are out of our control.

As I prepare to take a group of parishioners from St. Peter and St. Sylvester to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe on July 13, I'm reminded of Our Lady's similar words to the humble Mexican native Juan Diego. He is burdened by his uncle's serious illness and tries to quickly find a priest for Last Rites. She stops him along the way and tells him not to worry about this illness which is out of his control. She will take care of everything. He needs only to trust her. Our Lady tells him, "Do not be troubled or weighed down with grief. Do not fear any illness or vexation, anxiety or pain. Am I not here who am your mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection? Am I not your fountain of life? Are you not in the fold of my mantle? In the crossing of my arms? Is there anything else you need?"

It's with this confidence and assurance in the prayers of Our Lady and her watchful eye upon us that I bring with me many prayer intentions from St. Colman to place before Our Lady's miraculous countenance which appeared centuries ago on the tilma of Juan Diego. If only her image were placed confidently by each of us on our hearts!
