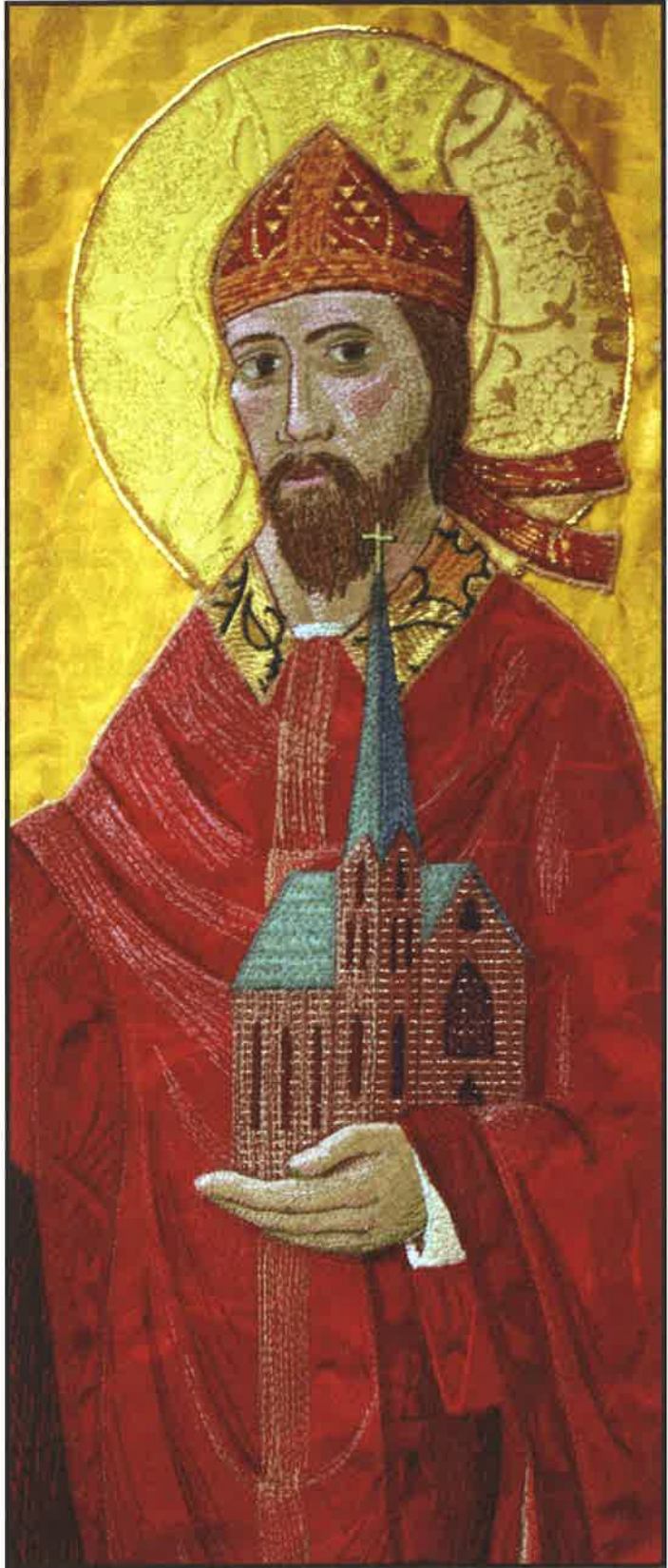

## From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar...

We rarely like to think about death, but this is one important and *unavoidable* topic that the holy season of Lent calls us to reflect upon more deeply. We are reminded on Ash Wednesday that we are mortal, and we will face death one day. Our penances, prayers and nightly examines help us prepare for that unfortunate event. Jesus' resurrection, however, fills us with hope that death is merely the end of our earthly lives. We hope for new life in Christ when we live with him, die with him and rise with him on the last day.

I'll be speaking to the Women of St. Colman this Monday, March 5 at about 1:00 p.m. on some areas of this topic. I'll try to be brief, and then have some time for questions before they move on with their meeting. All are welcome to attend this part of their meeting in the Conference Room.

This Sunday begins the Scrutinies. In the Liturgy of the Word in the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays we'll hear Scripture readings from Lectionary Cycle Year A. They may not be printed in the worship aid in the pews. These readings help the RCIA Catechumens and Candidates reflect more deeply on their lives and conversion. They help all of us do the same!

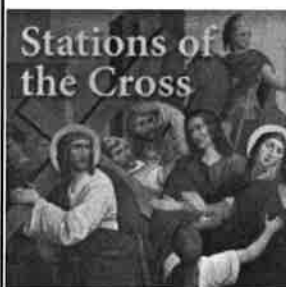


## Catholic Foundation Awards The LIFE Pregnancy Center

The LIFE Pregnancy Center acknowledges a \$10,000.00 grant received from the Catholic Foundation to assist funding an exterior beautification project to complement the newly constructed pregnancy medical center. The monies will help finance an outdoor patio setting, signage, landscaping, and the renovation of the perimeter wall in the back of the building.

The grant application was made through the St. Colman of Cloyne Catholic Church's social impact services which supports the work of the Center. The Center has been privileged to be chosen as a recipient of the Catholic Foundation Responsive Grant for the third year. A 2016 grant of \$20,000.00 helped purchase the property and kick-start the capital campaign for the new facility. A 2017 grant of \$40,500.00 helped finance the building's framework.
