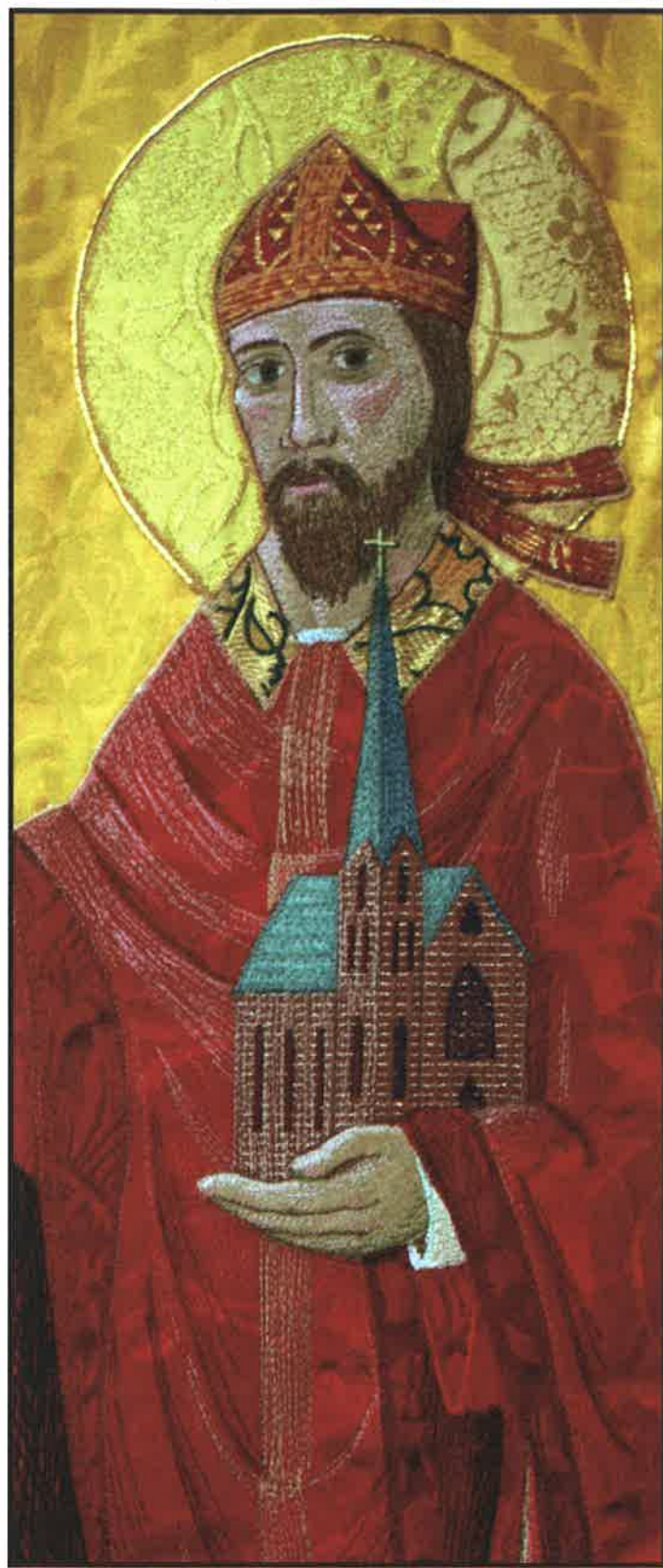

As we begin Advent next week, a reminder that there will be a few changes as Fr. Dooley becomes parochial vicar administrator here (in addition to remaining as such for St. Sylvester, Zaleski). Fr. Dooley will begin taking primary responsibility for pastoral care in the parish as Fr. Thomas has been. He will also take on some of the administrative oversight as Fr. Hartge did as parochial vicar administrator the prior two years. Fr. Thomas will take over primary pastoral duties for St. Peter's and St. Mary, Waverly. However, you will still be able to see Fr. Thomas from time to time here. Also, as Advent begins, a reminder to plan to set aside some time to make a good confession before Christmas. Next week, we'll list opportunities for confession in the parish as well as throughout the consortium. Happy Thanksgiving Weekend!

Notice for Tower Doors and Capital Improvement Collection

Next weekend is a Capital Improvement Collection weekend. As we announced in the Stewardship Lantern this fall, a Capital Improvement Parish Reserves Fund has been established to save contributions received specifically from this collection. Our hope was not to use these funds for quite some time. However, it has become apparent that we are going to need to do something about the tower doors very soon. The doors have not closed properly for quite some time... Requiring them to be slammed in order to be locked. (hence the signs posted to be sure the doors are closed tightly behind you). Last month, the doors were not tightly closed after someone exited them. The wind caught them and damaged the closure, lock and frame. Luckily someone happened by one Sunday evening, saw the church doors open and called so that they could be locked and the church secured for the night. Bruce Boylan, Director of Facilities for the Diocese, came down to inspect the doors and deems it necessary to replace them. He indicated that "fixing" them would only suffice for a short time. While this Capital Improvement collection has been scheduled on this weekend for the past few years, it comes at a very fortunate time this month. The doors will most likely be replaced as soon as possible. Our current savings in the Capital Improvement fund doesn't come close to covering the cost. We will have to dip into the main checking account to cover the rest in hopes that we exceed the BAA goal this spring so that some of the cost can be "reimbursed" through that campaign. In addition, Tina will apply for a Catholic Foundation grant next year in hopes of recouping the remainder of the expenses. Please consider donating to this campaign as you are able.

A side note regarding the tower doors: These doors will remain locked until the issues have been addressed. (You will still be able to exit through them in case of an emergency.) We ask that you enter and exit using the side doors on the south side. This may help prevent the church from being left unsecured in the event someone exits those doors after the staff has locked up after Mass.

Deposits and Reservation Forms must be turned in by **December 15, 2018**. Please make all checks out to NAWAS International. Check and paperwork should be sent to the attention of Jenny French at St. Peter's, 285 W. Water Street, Chillicothe 45601.

Check the date on your passport. It must expire six months AFTER the date of the Pilgrimage (November 15, 2019), so it should expire no earlier than April of 2020. If it expires between November 15, 2019 and April 1, 2020, you will need to renew it prior to the trip. Any renewal and purchase of new passport should be done as soon as possible. The travel agency will need a copy of the passport by the final payment date of July 28, 2019.

Living the Liturgical Year Celebrating Saints and Feasts to Enrich Hearts and Homes

November 25: Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

This feast was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism. How we need to embrace and celebrate this feast today for the same reason! To proclaim Christ as King over all; individuals, families, society, governments and nations...for He truly is! Christ the King is a moveable feast and is celebrated on the final Sunday of the liturgical year; a beautiful and fitting reminder of Christ's glorious and ultimate victory as we look ahead into Advent "to await with joyful hope of the coming of the Lord".

To honor **Christ as King** of our families and homes consider having your home **enthroned to the Sacred Heart of Jesus!** Check the bulletin or the parish office for information.

We decided to celebrate this grand feast with an easy persimmon "crown" cake. We make the cake in a bundt pan (they can be found in many crown like shapes) but any bundt will do. Persimmons are traditionally known as "God's pears" or "divine fruit"!

RECIPE: Persimmon "Crown" Cake (from catholiccuisine.com)

1 pkg Yellow Cake Mix	2 eggs
water or milk	3/4 persimmon pulp (can substitute pumpkin)
1 tsp cinnamon	1/2 tsp nutmeg
1/4 tsp cloves	3/4 cup walnuts, chopped (optional)

Directions:

Place cake mix in a large mixing bowl; add eggs and 1/3 cup LESS water (I use milk) than called for on package of cake mix. Add spices and persimmon (or pumpkin if using) and mix as directed on package. Stir in nuts. Pour into a greased 2 qt bundt pan. Bake at 350F for 45-55 minutes. Cool. Dust with powdered sugar.

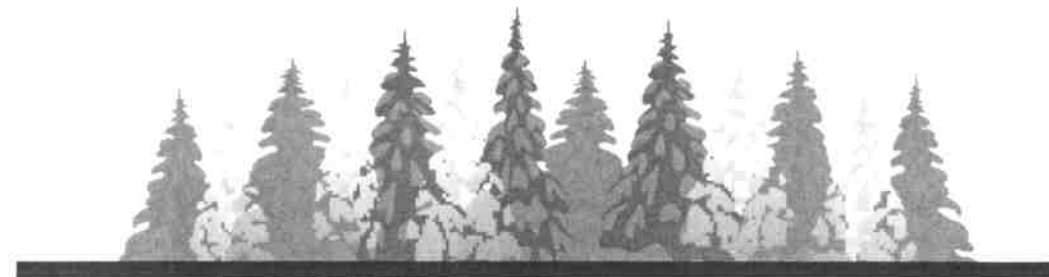
