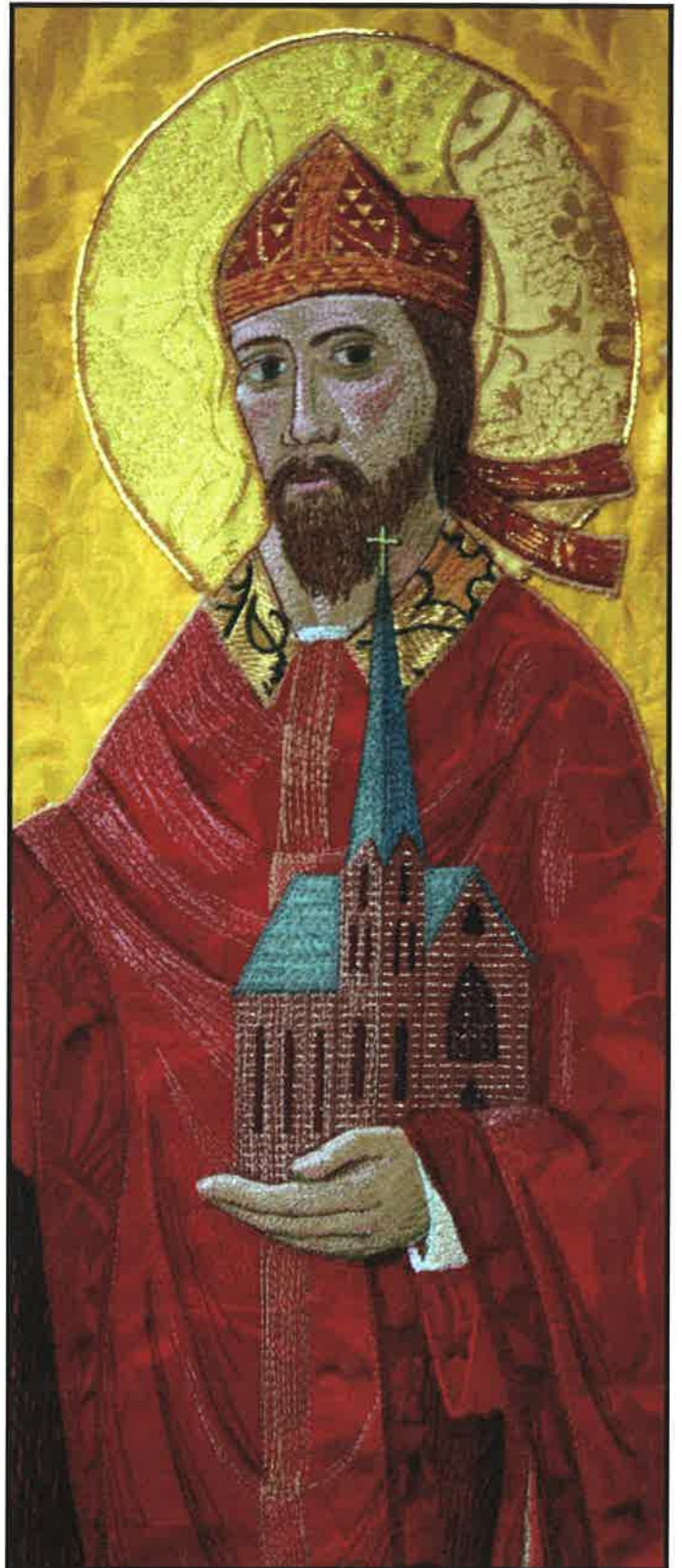

Capital Improvement Collection Next Weekend

Next weekend is the first of four Capital Improvement collections we have each year. We currently have several projects your Capital Improvement contributions will go towards: (1) The wet fall and winter have taken a toll on our roofs. Able Roofing will be here in the next couple of weeks to repair the roof over the church addition and replace the gutter on the Parish Hall that came down with the ice; (2) Repairs to the plumbing may be necessary in the rectory. It flooded during both of the heavy rains we had this past month; (3) One of the boilers in the church had to be repaired; (4) The blower motor in the Parish Hall had to be replaced; (5) The circuit board for the CO2 detector had to be replaced in the Parish Hall. And then finally, the tower door project still needs to be completed.

Please know that maintaining our parish buildings and grounds are of the utmost priority. Dave and Paul, with support from Fr. Hahn and Fr. Dooley, do not let maintenance issues lag. They are on top of issues as soon as they arise.

Thank you for your continued support of these collections. Please give next weekend as you are able. Your contributions will be a great help to manage these expenses.

Preparing for LENT!

Lent is the penitential season of the Church's year. It runs from Ash Wednesday to the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. There are six Sundays in Lent. The sixth is named Passion (or Palm) Sunday and starts Holy Week. Many people maintain their penances all through Lent including Sunday, but it is not uncommon or forbidden to relax a penance or two on Sundays to celebrate the Lord's day. Make this your best lent ever by making your best preparation for Lent EVER! Start with making your own Lenten calendar - you can find calendar printouts and step by step at <https://www.showerofrosesblog.com/2014/03/lenten-calendar.html>. Next sign up for a FREE!! email program from Dynamic Catholic that sends you daily reflections - here's the link <https://dynamiccatholic.com/best-lent-ever/>. Then - make a PLAN for your prayers, penances and Almsgiving. Below are some ideas you may not have considered before:

Practice one of the beatitudes each week, Replace 30 minutes of daily TV with 30 minutes of extra silent prayer, Pray and sacrifice for a different individual of group each day, Imbibe only Catholic news (try Zenit, CNA, EWTN news etc), Don't complain about anything, Practice complete silence after 7PM, Go to confession every week, Volunteer (try local soup kitchens, nursing homes or the VA). RECIPE: Meatless Taco Pot Pie

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 - 15 oz can Black beans drained and rinsed
- 1/2 cup frozen corn with green and red peppers
- 1 - 10 oz can Cheddar Cheese condensed soup (or similar)
- 1 - 10 oz can Diced tomatoes and green chilies undrained
- 2 tablespoons (1/2 of 1.25 oz pkg) Taco seasoning
- 1 pkg (8 oz) refrigerated crescent roll dough

Directions:

Heat oven to 375F. Mix remaining ingredients (except puff pastry) in a microwave safe bowl and heat 6 minutes in Microwave stirring once at 3 minutes. Unroll crescent dough; separate into 8 pieces. Spread bean mixture in greased 9x13 baking dish; top evenly with crescent dough. Bake 15 minutes or until dough is golden brown and mixture is bubbly. Serves 6. Prep Time 6 minutes. Total Time 30 minutes.
