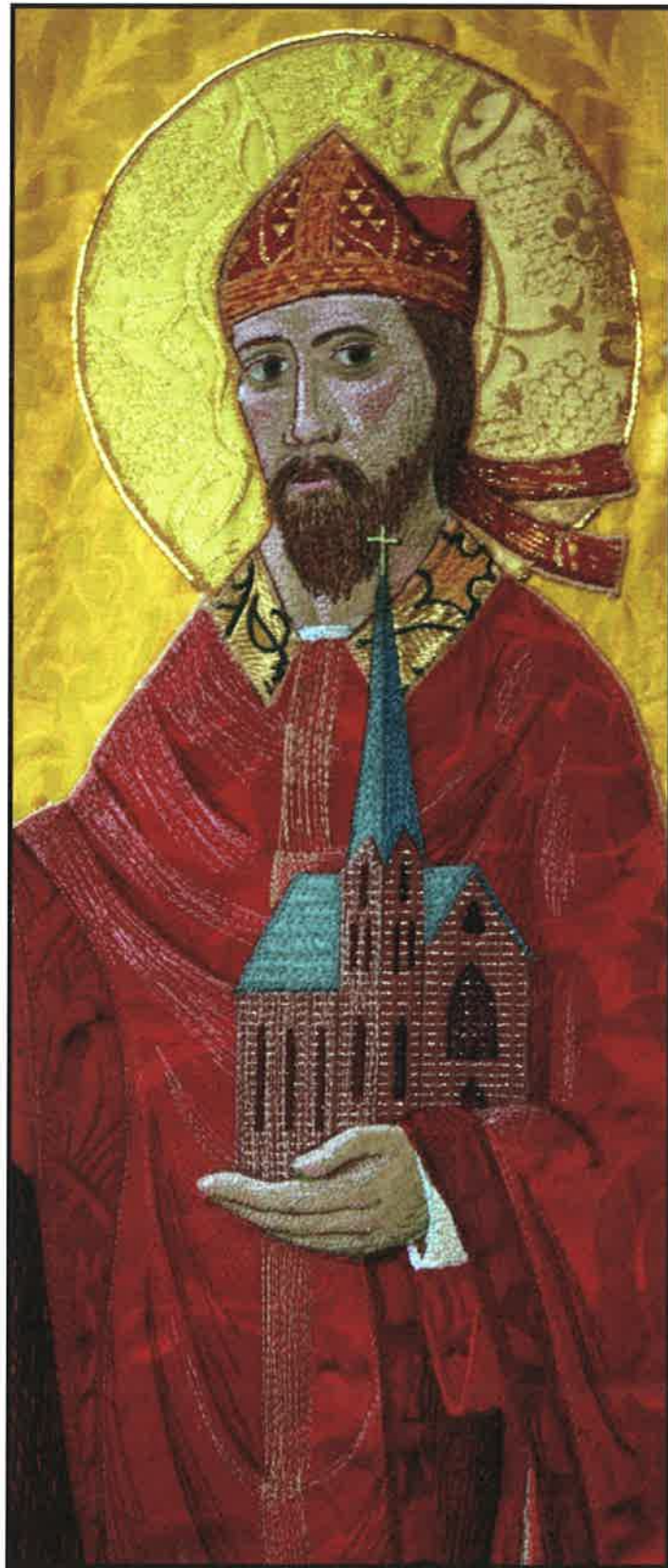

## From the Pastor's Desk...

This Wednesday begins the 40 days of Lent. Forty days of being with our Lord in the desert. This is a time of Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving.

## Disciplines

A reminder on the specific church disciplines of these forty days:

- ♦ **To FAST** means to eat one full meal and two lesser meals. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of FAST, and are kept by those aged 18 to 59. One is encouraged to fast on other days, too, throughout the year.
- ♦ **To ABSTAIN** means to refrain from eating meat, and soups or gravies made from meat. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence, as are all Fridays in Lent. Catholics aged 14 and older are bound to abstain from meat.
- ♦ We may observe fast and abstinence on other days, of course. Other practices, such as daily Mass, Bible reading and study, extra prayer, the Stations of the Cross, works of mercy, almsgiving, etc., are highly encouraged and not limited to Lent.

## Offering Box

This year instead of the CRS Rice Bowl Project we are doing our own Offering Box program. 50% will go to our St. Vincent DePaul Society to help those in need in our area. 50% will go to a special project at the orphanage we help support in Uganda: Miryante Orphanage. Be sure to take an offering box home with you today, fill it up throughout Lent with your gifts of alms, and then bring it back on Holy Thursday or Easter. As the boxes are smaller than the Rice Bowls, you might consider placing a bag near it at home to collect further, or take home a second box.

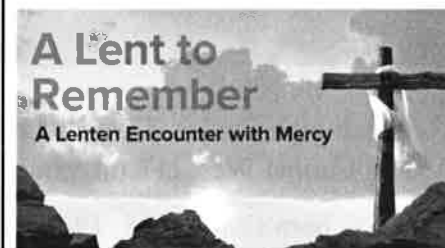

# Robert (Bob) Joseph Snider "Boo"

October 28, 1941 - February 24, 2019

Robert Joseph Snider, 77, of Washington Court House, Ohio died Sunday, February 24, 2019, at 3:47 p.m. at Mount Carmel West in Columbus where he had been a patient since February 4.

Bob was born October 28, 1941, in New York, New York to Joseph Albert and Mary Grace Beasley Snider. He moved to Somerset, Ohio at an early age and was a graduate of Holy Trinity High School in Somerset. He received a bachelor's degree in business administration from Ohio University and moved to Washington Court House in 1970.

He was a certified public accountant and co-owner and treasurer of Greenfield Research, Inc.

Bob was a member of St. Colman of Cloyne Catholic Church; the Washington Shrine Club and was a life member of Washington Lodge #129 of the Fraternal Order of Elks and Paul H. Hughey Post #25 of the American Legion. He served as treasurer of the Fayette Area Chamber of Commerce for 25 years. He was a veteran of the United States Army, having served in Germany and Korea. Bob was an avid golfer.

He is survived by his wife, the former Renee Ann Socie, whom he married June 20, 1970; a daughter and son-in-law, Carrie and Matthew Phillippi of Mason, Ohio; four grandchildren, Max, Andrew, Dylan and Benjamin Phillippi; two brothers; a sister; three brothers-in-law and their wives and several nieces and nephews.

In keeping with his wishes, cremation has taken place.

A Memorial Mass will be held Monday, March 4, 2019, at 10 a.m. at the St. Colman of Cloyne Catholic Church with the Rev. Father Sean Dooley, parochial vicar administrator at the church, officiating. The Women of St. Colman will provide a luncheon immediately following the Mass.
