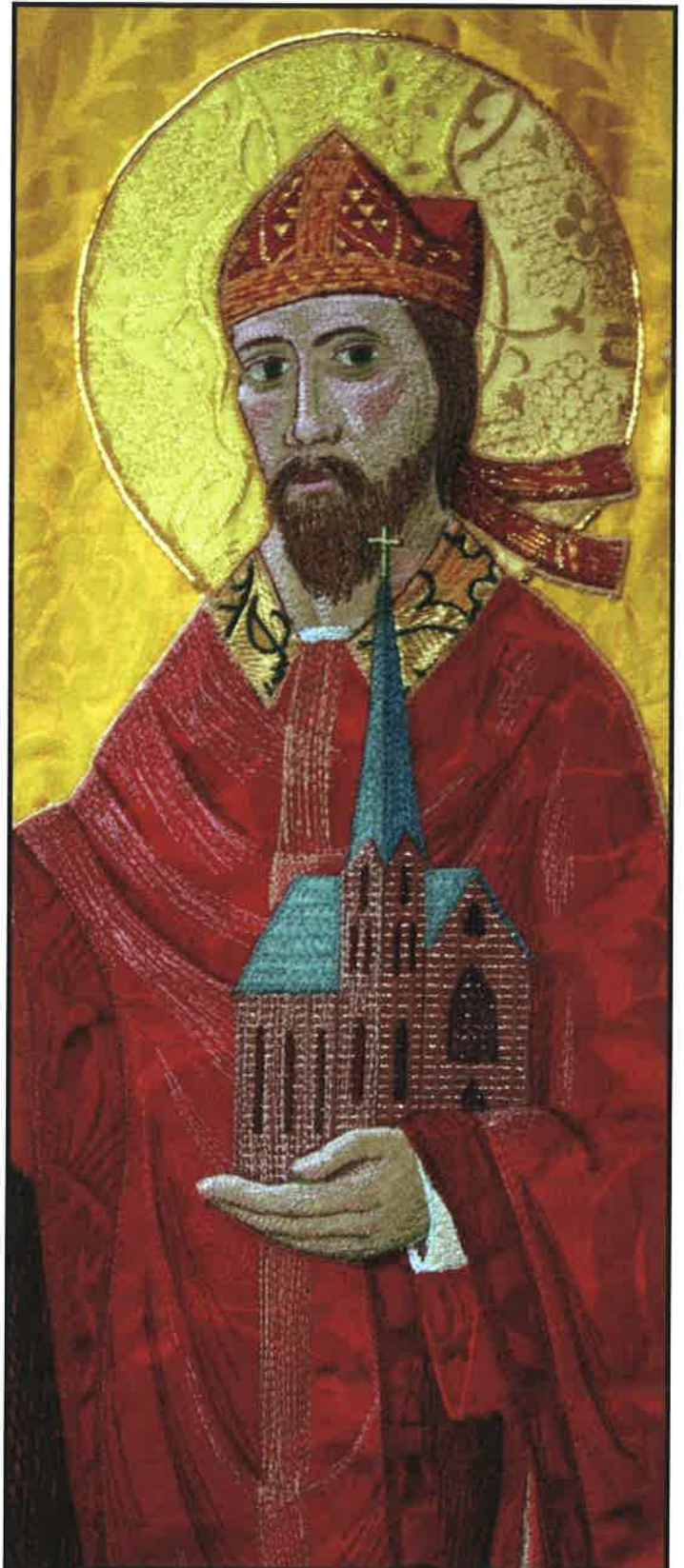

## From the Desk of Fr. Dooley...

Here is a striking quote from Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., that I would like to share with you: "Easter comes out ringing in terms that we all hear if we seek to hear it, that the soul of man is immortal. Through the resurrection of Jesus Christ we have fit testimony that this earthly life is not the end, that death is just something of a turn in the road, that life moves down a continual moving river, and that death is just a little turn in the river, that this earthly life is merely an embryonic prelude to a new awakening, that death is not a period which ends this great sentence of life but a comma that punctuates it to more loftier significance. That is what it says. That is the meaning of Easter. That is the question that Easter answers – that death is not the end." ## YEAR OF THE FAMILY

### Celebrating Saints and Feats to Enrich Hearts and Homes

#### Week Of April 28<sup>th</sup> – May 4<sup>th</sup>

**St Louis Marie Grignion de Montfort** (31 January 1673 – 28 April 1716) From his childhood, he was indefatigably devoted to prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, and, when from his twelfth year he was sent as a day pupil to the Jesuit College at Rennes, he never failed to visit the church before and after class. He joined a society of young men who during holidays ministered to the poor and to the incurables in the hospitals, and read for them edifying books during their meals. At the age of nineteen, he went on foot to Paris to follow the course in theology, gave away on the journey all his money to the poor, exchanged clothing with them, and made a vow to subsist thenceforth only on alms. He was ordained priest at the age of twenty-seven, and for some time fulfilled the duties of chaplain in a hospital. In 1705, at the age of thirty-two, he was appointed Apostolic Missionary by Pope Clement XI, and thereafter devoted himself to preaching to the people. During seventeen years he preached the Gospel in countless towns and villages. As an orator he was highly gifted, his language being simple but replete with fire and divine love. His whole life was conspicuous for virtues difficult for modern degeneracy to comprehend: constant prayer, love of the poor, poverty carried to an unheard-of degree, joy in

humiliations and persecutions. Montfort is known for his particular devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and the practice of praying the Rosary. If you haven’t already, consider doing a personal total consecration to Mary according to the method of St Louis de Montfort.



#### FEASTING WITH THE SAINTS

##### Our Lady of Lourdes Croque Madame (French grilled ham and cheese)

- 1.5 tsp all-purpose flour
- 1.5 tsp unsalted butter
- 1/4 cup milk
- salt & pepper to taste
- 2 slices French or sourdough bread
- 2 tsp dijon mustard
- 3 slices of ham
- 2.5 oz gruyere cheese shredded
- 1 fried egg
- thyme to garnish

1. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Begin by creating the Béchamel sauce. In a medium saucepan over medium heat, warm the milk until it's hot and steam is rising from it, but don't let it boil! In a separate medium saucepan, melt the butter over medium-low heat. Once melted, add the flour and whisk to combine. After about a minute, the roux (butter and flour) should become bubbly and hot. Stream the hot milk into the prepared roux, whisking vigorously as you do. Set the saucepan over medium-low heat and whisk until it's thick and coats the back of a spoon. Add small pinch of salt and pepper, to taste. Temporarily set aside. 2. Set one of the bread slices on a small baking sheet. Spread

the Dijon mustard on the bread. Top with the 3 slices of ham, rolling the slices first to get them to neatly fit side-by-side. 3. Add half of the shredded cheese on top of the ham. Toast this open-faced sandwich in the oven until the cheese has melted - about 5 to 7 minutes. 4. Add the remaining bread to the top of the sandwich. Pour the Béchamel sauce into the crevices of the top waffle. Add the remaining shredded cheese on top. Place under the broiler in the oven for a minute or two, or until the cheese has all melted and becomes bubbly. 5. Before serving, place the fried egg on top along with a sprinkle of thyme leaves.
